Queen at the top of her powers live in her homeland! Live at Wembley '83 is a dynamic concert with Freddie Mercury breaking it as the dominant force that the rest of the band seems to spin. He wears various appearances such as a T-shirt, all the white gear, strappy pants, and in the end the real robes. He has the audience in the palm of his hand on every track, arguably one of the most extravagant charismatic artists who have adorned the stage. Freddie is a force to consider as he sings one treasure of the Queen after another, the highlights are here with the roar of One Vision, and Tie your mother down. Get into progressive territory with In The Lap Of The Gods... Seven Seas Of Rhye. A Kind Of Magic is another classic and in the next, Under Pressure, Freddie features the makeshift scat style and gets the crowd together. The concert promotes the new singles that will soon be released on the 1984 album The Works. Another One Bites The Dust is a killer track where Freddie struts from one end of the stage to the other and loses his jacket for a fussy joy. Who wants to live forever is powerful since Freddie is gone now, and this is the world we create? has emotional depth. The following rock songs are interesting, but not my favorite part of the concert. The next part is. Bohemian Rhapsody begins and the crowd roars and sings the words. In the opera section the band disappears and we see a psychedelic kaleidoscope of colors and images of the film clip band. Then they explode in the metal section. The bombs explode and Freddie crashes through the mist. The crowd is jumping. The sound is fantastic with the speakers at 10. Playing May's guitar is amazing. The crowd sings nothing really matters, and Freddie puts his head back and takes the atmosphere, and in the end everyone has their hands in the air. Hammer To Fall is a hard rock track that I'm not so familiar with, but it's great in concert with a cool riff and dynamic drums. On Radio Ga Ga, the new single at the time, Freddie loses his shirt completely and the girls clap. The best thing here is the way the public applauds in unneededness in coordinating the brand choir. Freddie raises his arms in flattery. There's a lot of electronics on this track, in particular. The main break is fantastic from May. We Will Rock You is as fantastic as ever with Roger Taylor's booming drum beat and eclectic May's guitar solo. Freddie looks glowing with a huge flowing white cape and a red striped jacket. The crowd sings loudly in this. The main rest is awesome, one of my favorite lead solos. This song moves immediately on Friends Will Friends and then the anthem par excellence We Are The Champions. The crowd also loves and sings each note, swinging and waving flags or flags. The ending is God Save The Queen with Freddie leaning over an ecstatic audience, has the red robes of royalty and lifts his crown firing Wembley's crowd. Thank you, God bless you, he says and the crowd sings 'God save the Queen'. A great Queen concert with the band at the top of their powers. It was recorded live on Saturday, July 12, 1986 during the Magic Tour at Wembley Stadium in London, England. The album was released on May 26, 1992, with a supplementary DVD released in June 2003. The album was remastered and re-released with bonus tracks in August 2003 in the United States as Live at Wembley Stadium after the add-on DVD. This name has also been used in later versions elsewhere, although they lack the bonus tracks included with the US version. A special edition DVD remastered was released on September 5, 2011 in the UK (which would have been Freddie Mercury's 65th birthday), and for the first time included Friday night's concert, in addition to Saturday night's show. Fragments of Friday's show were included on previous DVDs, but the remastered release marked the first time the concert has been performed in its entirety.
