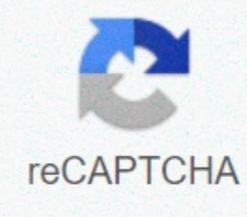

He said it was and an appointment for today Friday October 2 between 12 and 2 was agreed. He didn't show up or contact me that he wasn't going to. I had a 3 business day window to cancel my contract. This is obviously past and I have in no stretch of the imagination received any value for the 349.35 that was charged to my credit card. This amount was the initial service plus a one-month fee for the ongoing service. Needless to say, I am extremely unhappy with orkin pest control.
