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## **Erie elementary ks** The School Application UpdateA notes from Mr. Damman, superintendent of USD 101, provides you with an update for the school starting this fall. I'm sure everyone is excited to start school in some form or another and also concerned about the virus issue and how the school plans to address various issues. Much of the information is not yet known because, as you know, changes remain with the demands of social distancing and PPE. Several school districts postponed school starting until after Labor Day because of the governor's state order. Because the state school board did not approve the order, not all schools will be required to follow suit. The USD 101 Board of Education would like to start the school year as quickly as possible this fall because we don't have a large number of virus cases in our district. The committee stressed that they want to make sure the county is ready to meet quidelines to protect individuals from the virus as cited by the CDC. Not all the information from the beginning of the year has been fully finalised, but I feel it is important to convey what we currently know so parents can start planning for the school year. Enrolments will be postponed for a week and are scheduled for Tuesday, August 11, from noon to 8 p.m. and Wednesday, August 12, from 8 a.m. to noon. We make all enrollment information before coming to EHS and multiply the time it takes to get to the building. The first day of school for students has not yet been determined because board members must approve a change to the school calendar. The board will have an impact on different breaks and the end of the school year. This decision will be taken at a board meeting on 4 October. The committee will also have some discussion on PPE requirements for both students and staff members. It will be important for everyone to understand that there is a legal obligation that the committee will have to follow when making a decision for PPE. It will be easiest to follow the news from the state and county about how the district's requests will be handled and the different methods of receiving classes for students. This includes the traditional method of attending school in buildings and a possible remote environment where students will be at home receiving live classes from teachers. Regardless of the setting, it will be important to understand that all students will have to complete all the work required of teachers and students must be present all day of school regardless of location. Parents will get different options when enrolling students in August. More of this information will be provided after it is approved by the school board. Be sure to review social media, the district's website, and other phone notifications that are sent. The district's desire is to ensure the safety of all students and staff members at all times and to provide a high quality of education that allows our students to grow every year. I would like to thank all parents for your support of our district, teachers, administration and especially school board members as we move forward. We want to make the new school year just as important as every other school year and it will take everyone to work together to make it happen. Again, there will be more.
