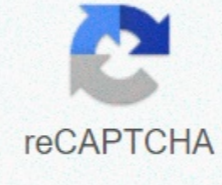

You can also view the searchable list of inmates currently housed in the prison here. You can search the list by last name, first name, offender status, race, gender and age. You can click on an inmate's file to access his booking photo, inmate number, booking number, arrest agency, crimes, date of arrest, next court date, court location, bond type, penalty date, security level, assigned location and biographical data. Important Jail policies and Procedures: Inmates are allowed to make 1 30-minute visit each week. Inmates can add up to 2 people to the approved visitors list at any one time. Visits must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance with the deputy unit. All visitors must register at the Justice Center. A photo ID must be presented upon arrival at the Justice Center. They're also doing a metal detector search. Juveniles must be accompanied by an adult. The inmate's visiting schedule is determined by his housing unit. The starting salary rate is \$27,880 a year. After several years, your salary can increase your average income to \$39,829. Ohio code 5503.02 states that candidates must be replaced by the 35th U.S. State. There are no exceptions or cancellations. Education: High school diploma or GED. Driver's license: You must have a valid operating licence, which currently has up to 6 points in the driver's register. You must obtain a valid driver's license before commission. Citizenship: Must be a citizen of the United States. Vision: It should be uncorrected vision no worse than 20/100 for each eye individually, corrected for 20/20 monocular vision. Color vision should be normal. Hearing: The hearing level shall not exceed 30 decibels at any of the following frequencies: 500 Hz, 1000 Hz, 2000 Hz, & 3000 Hz in each ear. Character: The applicant must have a good moral character. Application process: All steps in the application process have been successfully completed. Search for and search for sex offenders: Individuals convicted of sexually oriented offenses such as rape, child pornography, and sexual assault are required by law to submit information to the sheriff of the county currently living. U.S. County residents can also receive requests from the Vital Statistics Office of the Ohio Department of Health. It processes both the same day (in person) and the mail requests. To obtain the birth/death certificate by post, interested parties must send a completed application form to the Ohio Department of Health Bureau of Vital Statistics P.O. Box 15098 Columbus, OH 43215-0098 The class charges \$21.50 for each copy of the birth or death records.
