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100% cotton sateen, 600 thread count. Running over With so many bed start-ups promising premium quality, hotel-style sheets directly to consumer prices, it can be hard to know who is who. And warmer weather means that linen sheets, in particular, are enjoying their moment in the spotlight, with a slew of upstarts and new classics like Snowe, Parachute, and Brooklinen all offering their own versions of the back, rumpled fabric that still gives your bed a conscious look. To help us wade through the many styles and fabrics out there – crisp cotton percale, silky sateen, or anything in between – we reached out to design experts and tastemakers for their recommendations for the best sheet to buy, from classic, white Egyptian cotton to eco-friendly linen in completely bespoke sets. (And if you want to check out even more pages, we found the best reviewed sheets on Amazon, too.) Most of the options on this list are sold in totals that come with fitted sheets, flat sheets, and two pillowcases, but we've noted where the pieces are sold separately. And all specified prices are for queen size pages, unless otherwise stated. Finally, note the number of threads that we've listed in the cotton percale and other pages that provide it in your own name. Generally speaking, the higher the number of threads (or the number of threads per square inch of fabric) means that the sheets will be softer and more durable – and often more expensive – but experts say that buying leaves should not depend solely on the number of threads. Quality and production of yarn are also important, so be sure to consider all these aspects in the decision making. Matouk was by far the most recommended brand of our experts, with five designers calling it their favorite company beautiful, high quality pages. All percale sheets shown are made of 350 threads, long staple cotton, which is considered one of the highest quality threads. My favorite sheets are Matouk, mainly because everything is customizable, from colored threads to monogrammed and ruffles, says designer Sasha Bikoff, who told us Matouk's scallop embroidered sheets are the one style she always comes back. They're very Hollywood Regency and kind of Miami influenced, too. Designer Lindsey Coral Harper also loves Matouk's assortment of jagged edges, saying that Matouk bedding is a good option if you want something classic with a modern twist. Harper adds that percale fabric is one of my favorites to sleep, and the sheets mix and fit very well. Matouk's Sierra percale sheets are also interior designer Anne Hepfer's go-to option when she is looking for the ultimate luxury of quality and feel. Matouk's Sierra cotton percale sheets have a beautiful, classic base that can pair with any bed, she says. Meanwhile designer Vicente Wolf prefers Meridian sheets, which he says is his go-to style for most projects. There's something uniquely versatile about them – they're sophisticated enough in urban life, but even in rural homes they work perfectly against a more rustic background, he says. I never second guess these pages. Matouk's bedding is also among ariel okin's favorite sheets. Matouk sells its sheets and pillowcases separately, but it allows you to mix and match styles, as our designers have noted. Marimekko Ajo 200 Thread Count Cotton Sheet Set (Full) According to Alessandra Wood, VP Style online interior design service Modsy, cotton percale sheets are great when you run hot when you sleep. She says that while the number of threads is lower on these leaves, they are still crisp, cool and breathable. The tree gives patterned sheets to the hardwood, which is another reason she pointed us to this striped set of Finnish design house Marimekko (which, as we've written above, is beloved for its eye-catching prints). Snowe Percale 500 Thread Count Sheet Set Like Matouk sheets above, Snowe's percale sheets are also made from long staple cotton, and have a slightly higher thread number of 500, making this set particularly well priced if you believe that Matouk sheets are sold separately. They recommend Kai Avent-deLeon, owner of the tribute, Tommy. I really liked Snowe's dinnerware, so I started using my own pages, too, and I've found that they're really good quality and courtesy of price, she says. They cotton, which is the only material I buy now, and they're really soft, kind of plush. They're breathable and low maintenance, so I don't constantly clean them, although I buy off-white paint. If you're looking for something a little more affordable, Courtney McLeod, founder and chief designer of New York City-based Right Meets Left Interior Design, recommends this set of percale sheets from West Elm, which she says is great quality at a price. They are made from 100 percent organic cotton fair trade certified equipment and, in addition to white shown, they also come in cool silver. You can even get them on a monogram, for an additional fee. If you're looking for a little more texture for your leaves, West Elm also makes embroidered percale sheets, such as the above set with a fine diamond strip pattern that comes recommended by interior designers Tavia Forbes and Monet Masters Atlanta-based interior design studio Forbes and Masters. Although only a simple set lists the number of threads, both sets are made of fabric certified by the Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS certification is the leading standard for textiles made from organic fibres). This 300 thread count, cotton percale Chambers Cane sheets from Sonoma also came recommended for their delicate embroidered pattern. Interior designer Maggie Griffin says they feature lines of classic rust plexus, giving them just the right amount of graphic detailing. Bright white with intricate threads is just gorgeous, she says. For a slightly bolder embroidered design, Forbes and Masters pointed us to Williams Sonoma's Chain Link kit, which is named for its chain link-inspired model. John Robshaw Kama 200 Thread Count Sheet Set My Projects has intricate layers of color and pattern, but when it comes to sheets, I tend to veer to easy, boho vibes, says interior designer Rayman Boozer of 48 Apartment. He likes John Robshaw's bedding, and his go-to colors are light blues, pink, and grays. Writer Kate Betts also vouches on Robshaw's bed, which she first discovered in a friend's house in the south of France. She admits that Robshaw's sheets can be pricey, but soft cotton, unusual colors, and so that each model evokes Rajasthan dreamscape to make it worthwhile. This particular set has a block print pattern and the thread count is 200. Frette Hotel Classic Sheet Set (Queen) Of course, you can not talk fancy sheets without mentioning Frette, which was recommended by two of our experts. The room was quite small and the bathroom was quite small. Says Michael Shome, visuals director of Architectural Digest: My absolute favorite sheets are hotel classics from Frette, which is kind of like a fantasy version of upper east side hotel bedding. They're Italian made in this Egyptian cotton, which is just the softest and butteriest fabric to driIye around. I also like chic and simple double-line embroidery. Frette sheets are also what Okin turns when she searches for something classic. According to Frette's website, their percale sheets have a thread count between 200 and 240. Brooklinen Lina Core Sheet Set Lina sheets, which are made from natural fiber flax factories, are usually more expensive than cotton sheets because of their more involved manufacturing process and durability. They said to get better and softer over time, too, making them a nice long-term investment. If you're looking to explore linen sheets for the first time, Brooklinen's Luxe Hardcore kit is a good place to start. According to former strategist senior writer Lauren Levy, Brooklinen made me fall in love with linen sheets. She says they're so cozy and so soft and have an instantly worn-in feel that just gets softer over time and with every wash. Wood also loves this set, saying it makes a bit of an unexpected look in the bedroom. Linoto 100% Pure Sheet Set According to former strategist senior editor Margaret Rhodes, Linoto's linen sheets heavier and more like an idea for a legacy page than any other I've encountered. This is because, she explains, they're all made in upstate New York without using chemicals or enzyme prewash that many other linen leaf manufacturers rely on this lived-in feeling. All linoto fabric is a source of mills in Italy and Belgium, and Rhodes says they have the right ratio of soothing to crisp properties you want a good set of linen sheets. Forbes and Masters are also fans of Linoto's linen sheets, which are available in a whopping 25 different colors. Kultiver Linen Sheet Set They're on the pricier side, but these linen sheets from Cultiver come highly recommended by interior designer Tali Roth, who loves his effortlessly compressed and casual look and notes that they also come in a gorgeous assortment of colors. Interior designer Tina Rich agrees, saying Cultiver sheets instantly create a cozy, relaxed vibe. I always recommend to Culteer for your clients and use them in their own homes. She adds that the pages are supersoft and of

great quality. Although seen in white, if you're looking to try a colorful couple, Rich's favorite options are twilight, smoke gray, and sage. After testing a lot of different linen sheets, our editors agree that they are as soft as experts say, and come in some of the most unusual colors you can get. Parachute Linen Sheet Set by Top Sheet Top Chef Judge Gail Simmons turns the parachute into her linen sheets, in part because they didn't cost you a crazy amount. Again, we agree: We called Parachute to be the best all-around option for linen sheets because of their mid-of-the-road price, the essential mood of linen, and color options (such as this inviting soft cheek hue shown). Bella Notte Frida Pillowcase (Single) Bella Notte Frida Flat Sheet Bella Notte Linen Fitted Sheet Architect and designer Maria Augusta Louro told us about Bella Notte's linen beds (and the brand is mentioned elsewhere in this list of experts who love their leaves made from other fabrics). Louro says that while lying on 500-thread-count Egyptian cotton is nice, there's nothing like sleeping on linen that makes her feel so fresh. While Bella Notte's lingerie doesn't come cheap, you can buy each piece separately. She especially loves lace detailing on a Frida pillowcase and says that the collection is elegant, delicate in humane conditions, colored using low-impact dyes, and contains the lowest possible toxin levels. Bella Note's Frida flat sheet has the same lace detailing on its edges, and you can also buy an embellished lingerie-fitted sheets from the brand as well. My go-to and most beloved collection of bedding is manufactured by a company called Linge Particulier, says Jenny Dina Kirschner, chief of JDK Interiors. Commission 201 eco-friendly sheets are made from 100 percent biodegradable washed laundry, and come in an array of rich, earthy tones that she calls the most beautiful, vivid colors. Although the brand is expensive, she loves how low-maintenance they are: They can be washed and tossed dryer and don't ever need ironing, unlike the traditional crisp, cotton blanket and film that wrinkles after one night's use. Linge Particulier also sells a matching linen pillowcase for \$50. Pure Beech 100% Modal Sateen 400 Thread Count Sheet Set Thanks to their weave, sateen sheets, like these 100 percent modal sheets from Pure Beech, have a silkier feel than percale – and those that come recommend okin, are super comfy, according to him. Another fan of these pages is interior designer Sheila Bridges, who told us she has 20 or so sets of sheets in her closet and that they are the softest, so far. Bridges describe them as feeling almost feel like flannel, but very light, so they're not that warm – just really soft and comfortable with a touch. At \$100 for a queen size set, the price is reasonable enough that you can get a couple of pairs if you never want to go without them on your bed. The \$100 at Bed Bath & Beyond Threshold 400 Thread Count Solid Performance Sheet Set Target sells these sateen pages as part of its in-house Threshold line, and Forbes and Master recommend they have great quality at a great price. They add that these leaves come in a nice color range, including light indigo (shown here), rose, purple, cream, and dark purple. Made from 100 percent cotton, the 400-thread-count sheets are wrinkle-, pill-, and shrink-resistant for easy maintenance. Ikea Nattjasmin Sheet Set McLeod recommends this even more affordable set of sateen pages from Ikea. The silky sheets have a lustrous finish and are made of a mixture of lyocell and sustainably grown cotton. According to the product description, the production helps to draw and absorb moisture away from your body as you sleep, keeping you dry overnight. McLeod notes that a particularly deeply equipped page also works with thicker mattresses, adding: You can't beat this option at a price. Hill House Home Savile Quick Snooze Sheet Set Interior designer Hilary Matt's favorite sheets are these Saville sheets from Hill House Home, a brand Okin also loves for luxurious sheets. I love the crisp and clean hotel look they have when your bed is up, she says. They feel good and are supersoft and luxurious. This set, made from 100 percent matte cotton sateen, allows you to add a pop of color to its lovely piping detail, which you can get emerald, black or white. To add even more characters, you can customize hill house home pages with their initials, a feature that matt appreciates. BedVoyage bamboo rayon Set (Queen, Ivory) I recently used bamboo linen for a great project and I definitely used them more to go ahead, says Anishka Clarke, co-owner of Ishka Models. Bamboo is one of the most powerful and solid natural materials, and yet if you feel the fibers on these leaves, it is just incredibly soft. Softer than you imagined. Supersoft - like baby-soft on the skin. And since they are made of this strong bamboo, she adds, the sheets are very durable - they usually last about twice longer than cotton sheets. Bamboo sheets are usually more expensive, but the overall quality and durability make the fabric a free-to-air winner. Oasis Fine Linens Island Bamboo Collection, Charcoal Stripe These bamboo rayon sheets from Oasis Fine Linen are Decorilla designer Devin Shaffer's personal favorite when it comes to sheets. Shaffer, who has pets, points out that bamboo is an added benefit of naturally resisting odors and bacteria. He has gone through two of them in five years and says: They're perfect. Although this particular set does not count the number of threads, Shaffer notes that bamboo linen feels as soft as sheets whose thread count reaches up to 2000. Bamboo sheets are also great for night jumpers, as their excellent moisture forking and insulating properties help regulate body temperature. Mellanni Bed Sheet Set – Matte Microfiber 1800 Bed Linen Designer Ashley Moore loves these Mellanni sheets (which has over 60,000 reviews on Amazon) for several reasons – number one is the price tag. You can't beat these at a price, she says. According to Moore, they're made of brushed microfiber, which is a supersoft. If you read all the reviews, you hear almost everyone say the same thing, she says. That's why we have these in every guest bedroom in our home. For years, I've been using Comphy as my go-to for wrinkle-free, supersoft sheets, says interior designer Caitlin Murray, founder of Black Lacquer Design. These sheets are made of microfiber tread, which, according to the website, is comparable to 600 threads in the number of pages. Comphy started as a hotel spa line, so the leaves are particularly durable and stain resistant, Murray adds. Bonus: They're also recyclable. Bella Notte Madera Luxe Fitted Sheet Bella Notte Madera Luxe Flat Sheet Bella Notte Madera Luxe Pillowcase (Single), While Comphy makes her go to the page, Murray says that when it comes to super-fancy ones, Bella Notte is my favorite luxury bed brand. She especially loves her infant Madera sheets, calling them seriously divine. They're made of Tencel, a sustainable fiber that is soft and breathable like cotton. She usually goes with white on her leaves, but points out that Bella Notte is the curator of a selection of beautiful colors that are and clothing. Like Bella Notte's linen sheets, each piece is sold separately. The Ink + Ivy Heathered Cotton Jersey Knit Sheet Set Jersey sheets are incredibly comfortable and low maintenance, according to strategist senior writer Karen Iorio Adelson, which is why they have her bed of choice. According to her, two of the biggest benefits of jersey sheets are that they never wrinkle and feel like sleeping in your favorite T-shirt every night. Her personal favorite is what's in the Ink + Ivy, which she calls butter soft and durable, standing up to a lot of washing and wear. Plus, she adds, they've actually become more comfortable over time, just like a beloved T-shirt. Coyuchi Organic Jersey Sheets If sustainability is a priority for you, Adelson recommends trying out this jersey sheet made from Coyuchi, the maker of some strategist approved bath towels and linen sheets. Although these sheets are on the pricey side of jersey sheets, you can sleep easier knowing that they are made from 100 percent organic cotton without the use of toxic bleaches, dyes and other chemicals. Once you're done with them, you can send them back to rebuild, recycle, or upcycled (and kept from landfills) as part of Coyuchi's 2nd Home program and get 15 percent off on your next purchase. Kumi Kookoon Classic Fitted Sheets Unlike satin sheets that simply feel silky, sheets made of actual silk are the real deal. But, like anything made of silk, they come at a price, which is why starting out with a silk pillowcase could be a good toe-dip before investing in everything that, according to Zoe Mac, founder of Zoe Mac Design. You don't end up with so many pillow folds, it's softer on your skin, and your hair isn't so frizzy when you wake up. Mac says about the benefits of silk pillowcases. While Mac thinks that most silk pillowcases on the market can be really sticky, these, from Kumi Kookoon, are the exception. They are in this range of incredible colors. I use a very deep indigo-fleet, and it's a dream to sleep on. They are so soft and I really notice the difference when I wake up. My hair is not so crazy in the bed in the morning and my skin feels better. If you like pillowcases and want to sleep fully surrounded by silk, you can splurge on one of Kumi Kookoon's flat silk sheets and fitted sheets that come in over 30 colors. The strategist is supposed to surface the most useful, expert recommendations for things to buy throughout the vast e-commerce landscape. Some of our newest conquerors include the best comforters, bath towels, mattress toppers (twice), pillows for side sleepers, a strange knees chair, and sleepers. We update the links if possible, but note that the offer may expire and all prices may change. 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
