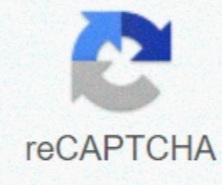

MacRumors spotted that the app can be downloaded now for most people, but it may still be taking its time propogating to international App Stores. The app is, of course, free.
