Despite Capelli's enthusiasm, the numbers aren't pretty. And revenue and enrollment are down about 14% from this time last year, and Apollo's stock has fallen 30% since the data was released, according to CNN. Right, things are bleak. But the truth is, the University of Phoenix, and others like him, have been marked for death for some time. For-profit colleges and online educators like U of P at one point had an effective monopoly on online education, but this simply is no longer the case. For a company offering lower product quality at an inflated price, it is quite clear that the management of these types of companies is probably at the end. Source: University of Phoenix Official Page in Phoenix The most obvious problem for Apollo and its competitors is that traditional public and private universities are catching up with them. When the University of Phoenix first entered the internet and became a new option for prospective students across the country, they had a new and sought-after product that could be accessed from anywhere to anyone, breaking down the two biggest barriers to college education for most people. This, in turn, allowed them to charge heavily inflated prices for training. Through some fantastic fudging and manipulation, U of P and its inc. millions in take out huge loans through the government to pay for their education and use taxpayer dollars to increase their profits. These practices lead to a snub in the public domain, a few less than flattering investigative documentaries and a general agreement among many employers that education by nature is less than those of a traditional school. Essentially, these schools will give degrees to anyone willing to pay for it, rather than through achievement and merit-based programs used by traditional colleges. But simply comparing the numbers from a standard public four-year university with a university program in Phoenix shows the real problem. According to the College Affordability and Transparency Center, part of the Department of Education, the University of Phoenix costs \$14,550 a year to attend, and has a 19% graduation rate. While public universities aren't much cheaper these days, on average around the same price, they have a much better experience of graduating their students, about 57%, and putting them into jobs afterwards. Now that most major colleges have their own online programs, there is no incentive for a future student to choose the University of Phoenix over one of the public, or even more expensive but prestigious private university. Ultimately, the Apollo Group apparently helped invest in naming an NFL football stadium after the organization, rather than reinvesting in improving its platform. With all this in view, it's time to worry if you're part of the Apollo system. To compete, some big changes will have to be made, and it is unclear whether the business model can cope with these changes. Other similar companies are already closed, and the latest numbers may be the first sign that the University of Phoenix will fail.
