Throughout the track calls himself a monster and even conjures images of Wuoros. It's an interesting move, considering Nicki claimed monster man years ago, especially in Kanye West's single Monster. What does all this mean? In short, Cardi is as bad as ever and he won't let the press, his critics or his enemies slow him down. Welcome to The Drop, Refinery29's new home for exclusive music video premieres. We want to shed light on female artists whose music inspires, inspires and (literally) moves us. This is where we defend their voices. Pop has always been a place for women to regain their sexuality and intimacy - Man, I feel like a woman and Christina Aguilera's Beautiful, genre fits in to evoke the anthems of strength and individuality. Rachel Crow's Dime continues this tradition: The song is about self-appreciation — I'm an inch, Crow assures me that he doesn't mean a penny in the sense of a perfect 10. There is no such thing as a perfect ten; That's the point, he tells Refinery29 by phone. The song is not about the sliding scale of intrinsic value, but about natural value, period. It's also, like the best anthems, boppy, unapologetic fun. The accompanying video, which premieres exclusively with Refinery29, is equally unapologetic: It's a phone-free celebration of teen hangouts in the '90s, filled with Jeep Wrangler and drive-in movies. Crow is dressed in Paco Rabonne's sports bra and slouchy sweatpants – a vision of retro nostalgia in 2017. He wrote Dimes two and a half years ago when he was only 17. Today, at the age of 19, the singer seems eager to get a more grown-up show on the road, especially as she's been on the teen circuit for some time. Crow was conceived at the age of 13 on X Factor. The precociote and far too cute Colorado native was a fan favorite. However, he didn't make it to the end, and Crow says it's for the better. If he had won X Factor, he might not be who he is today: a 19-year-old multi-syllable with a future role in Bumblebee and obsessed with uncertainty. (He's angry with both Issa and Lawrence for his actions in the Season 2 premiere.) Refinery29: Tell me how you wrote Dime. It's full of money-word games! Rachel Crow: yes! We just wanted a fun, feisty throwing song. We tried a few things, and I don't know about this. But then we got 10 cents and said, That's funny. And after that, we kind of messed around, but we just said, How many puns can you fit in one song? And it worked! It was humorous, but clever. In fact, my friend - one day he finally heard the lying Save Apologies [I'm not an interchange jacket] - and he said: What? He's gone. We kind of wanted to mix the simple and very complicated and I think it came up well. I also like the words invest in me. Any extra exchange is still valuable. Yes, it was meant to be - appreciating someone is a big deal, and I think appreciating someone is even bigger, especially in today's world, where you have relationships or why do you call when you're dating someone, but they don't want a label, you know what I mean? That's what my song is all about - I want everyone to feel good. I also want them to know that you deserve the world. You deserve to be appreciated. Definitely! I think it's funny that everyone reacts so well because in today's world, it's the truth. There are no relationships! There's a strange energy between two people, and you think you're an exclusive, but you don't talk about who you are because there's some stigma in it. I think Dime's kind of the point of this song everyone understands and accepts each other. Is it a relationship in particular? Not for this song. I have several songs - I even have one called 'Dishonest', which is about a particular person. Just because I'm 19! No, it's okay, it's okay, it's okay. You go through things and go through heartache. But not especially this song. I kind of pulled out of a lot of different experiences, even experiences that weren't mine. This was essentially a common call: Hey! All right, listen up. I'm sure you can hear those diss songs. Hi! You broke my heart. What's the matter with you? Those. And they are definitely about a specific person. Speaking of which, have you ever been ghosted? No, I've ghosted someone. No, no, no. Yes, I am. Because people treat you like shit! And they expect you to just didn't talk to them anymore. Did you just delete their number from your phone? I didn't delete their number in case they texted me one day and I didn't know who it was and I answered them. But I stopped talking to them. And it worked because they got the picture! The original treatment was 50s style but I didn't want it because I'm not that. I used to be that girl when I was younger, but now I've really changed, and I'm really have stuff for a Mustang convertible - it was just, 'This is your car.' I got a text on the morning of the shoot: Red or blue? I wanted a screenshot because this is my life? No, no, no. We got to the shoot, and it was better than I could have imagined. I'm dancing in this video! I've never dance before. Have you ever studied dance before? Not! No, it's not. I think I have a sense of rhythm. I love to dance, let go and have fun. But I've never danced. The day before I had two hours of rehearsals with my choreographer Ritchie, which is amazing. But that's the day I just went. I did it perfectly; There was nothing strange. When the camera cut, everyone jumped up and started screaming and cheering. I was freaking out because it was my first time and it was so nice that I did a good job. You're working hard! You have the Bajillion Project coming up. What are you doing to turn off the fumes? I really love lying in bed and watching Netflix and eating junk food. I know every 19-year-old probably says that. I love insecure and I keep hearing that GLOW is good. Maybe it's next. Your departure on X Factor was some way dramatic. People are still commenting on the YouTube video of your deletion saying they haven't forgiven Nicole Scherzinger for letting you go. Have you forgiven him? Ugh. All right, listen up. There was nothing to forgive. Everyone has to remember that it was a reality show. Nicole Scherzinger is not to blame for anything about me. I'm glad I didn't win. The end result would have been very different, and I like where I am today. It's been six years! What do you think is the song of the summer? The person who is annoying inside me says 'Dime.' But my song of the summer is [Future's]' 'Mask off.' Whenever it comes on, I just can't move. This interview has been edited and condensed for clarity. Clarity.
