WAYNE — Beachgoers found a new location on Lake Toms in its opening weekend, with equal parts of sand and surfing, and a touch of social distancing. About 275 people went to the lake owned by the municipality in Capt. Michael Kilroy Memorial Park between Saturday and Sunday, according to Timothy Roetman, director of parks and recreation. Roetman said the number of badge holders is lower than usual for this stage of the season, and lake attendance this past weekend reflected that. One possible reason for the slow start may be the fact that the municipality's pool is not yet open. That outlook changed on Monday when Governor Phil Murphy said municipal pools can open in two weeks. It is expected to provide further guidance on Tuesday. Lake membership is affected by officials' inability to open the pool because possession of a pool badge - \$190 for an individual - allows guests to visit any of the facilities. A lake badge costs \$100 per person. People are waiting to see what they're going to get for their money, Roetman said before the governor's announcement. Roetman said the municipality averages about 4,250 badge holders each summer and that the largest wave of new members usually comes in the weeks leading up to the Fourth of July. His time helped businesses begin to recover at Memorial Day destinations along the coast.
