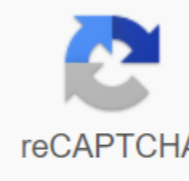




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The child behavior checklist manual achenbach

Checklist for children's behavior for ages 4-18 years is designed to record children's competences and problems, as reported by their parents or surrogate mothers. It can be managed independently or administered by the interviewer. The 20 points of competence receive reports from parents on the size and quality of their child's participation in sports, hobbies, games, activities, work and duties, and friendships; how well the child get along with others and plays and works alone; school functions. Each of the 118 specific problem items and two open edge issue items are noted on a 3-step responsibility scale. The checklist is designed for only one component of many, including teacher reports, standardized tests, physical evaluation and direct assessment of the child. Reliability and validity are discussed. Skipping to basic content Skip to the Achenbach Empirical Assessment-Based System (ASEBA) content includes a family of forms to assess behavioral/emotional problems and adaptive characteristics. For ages 11/2 to 90, development forms are designed to be filled in by collateral holders who know the rated entity. These forms include versions of the Child Behaviour Checklist (CBCL) completed by parent figures for 11/2- to 5-year-olds and for 6- to 18-year-olds; a caring teacher's report form (C-TRF) for ages 11/2-5, supplemented by care providers and preschoolers; a teacher's report form for ages 6 to 18 completed by teachers and other school staff; Adult Behaviour Checklist (ABCL) for ages 18-59, completed by spouses, partners, family members, friends, therapists and other collateral; and a checklist of adult behaviour for ages 60 and over, supplemented by carers as well as collateral.
