The site site website website area and school sites are a great source for parents and public information. During an emergency and/or weather affecting our schools, the region's website will provide important details (on the home page) about any school closures or emergencies. In an emergency, the area may send you detailed information via email. You may also receive school publications sent directly to your email (see below). The Oxnard school area mobile app collects content from the parent alert system, county location, social networking sites in the area, and parent and student portals to provide an information store.
