The franchise revolves around a boy named Ben Tennyson who acquires an alien clock-style device, the Omnitrix, which contains DNA from different alien species and allows him to transform into ten aliens initially and later on new aliens are added in the Omnitrix. The Ben 10 franchise received widespread critical acclaim, winning three Emmy Awards. The franchise consists mainly of five television series and four films, the latter being aired between August 2007 and March 2012. At the age of 14, it is cartoon network's longest franchise to date. There is also a Ben 10 toy line manufactured by Bandai for the first four shows and Playmates Toys for the reboot. Worldwide, the franchise has grossed more than \$6 billion in retail sales. On his first night camping in his grandfather's trailer (nicknamed rust bucket), Ben finds a mysterious watch-style device called the Omnitrix that attaches to his wrist, giving him the ability to transform into various alien life forms each with special abilities. During their vacation, the Tennysons are attacked by various enemies, from aliens such as intergalactic warlord Vilgax, The pair of bounty hunters Sixsix and Kraab, Ectonurite high king Zs'skayr, criminals such as 11-year-old delinquent Kevin Levin, mad scientist Doctor Animo, the mysterious paramilitary organization The Forever Knights, and supernatural entities like the interdimensional wizard Hex and his niece Charm. , and the clown's mentor Zombozo and his Circus Freak Trio. Ben 10: Alien Force Main Article: Ben 10: Alien Force The series begins five years after the summer holidays when Ben discovered the Omnitrix. Ben removed the Omnitrix because he lost the alien feedback shown in omniverse, but recovered it as a teenager while searching for his grandfather Max, who was abducted by a xenophobic alien species called Highbreeds, who, along with the DNAliens at his command, are determined to rid Earth of humans. Ben's age causes the Omnitrix to restart, granting him access to new alien forms along with some of his previous forms. Ben is accompanied by Gwen and former foe Kevin Levin as they fight the hightbreed's universal extermination plan. Ben 10: Ultimate Alien Main article: Ben 10: Ultimate Alien After Ben's last battle with Vilgax, who destroyed the Omnitrix, Ben replaces him with the new Ultimatrix that allows him to evolve his alien forms into their final forms. With the recent disclosure of his identity, Ben has become a worldwide celebrity. Meanwhile, Ben, Gwen and Kevin must stop an Osmosis villain named Aggregor, who hunts aliens from the Andromeda Galaxy and intends to use his powers to reach the ultimate prize. Later, Ben, Gwen and Kevin have to prevent an extra-dimensional entity called Diagon from from snare the universe. Ben 10: Omniverse Main Article: Ben 10: Omniverse Ben acquires the new and improved Omnitrix, which gives him access to a new set of aliens along with all the forms he took before. After Gwen goes to college with accompanying her, Ben paired it with Rook Blonko, a plumber from the planet Revonnah. He is the target of a one hunter named Khyber, who made a copy of the Omnitrix, the Nemetrix, with the help of mad scientist Dr. Psychobos. Both are working with an enemy of Ben's past, a galvanic Mechamorph named Malware. Ben later fights with the Incurseans, Albedo, Zs'Skayr, Dr. Psychobos, Charmcaster, the Plumber's Black Operations Unit (called rooters), his alternative dimension self Mad Ben, and the Chronosapien Maltruant. Ben 10 (TV series 2016) Main article: Ben 10 (2016 TV series) Cartoon Network PR's official Twitter feed[3] confirmed a restarted series that would re-follow the adventures of Ben, Gwen and Max Tennyson and introduce new alien forms. In mid-June 2016, Cartoon Network released the first poster of the series, in which ten of the franchise's most popular aliens were featured. The series would debut on Cartoon International Networks from October 2016, with Versions of Europe, Asia Pacific, Middle East & Africa, and continuing in 2017 with the North American and Latin American versions. [4] The world premiere was on Cartoon Network (Australia and New Zealand), which airs on October 1, 2016. The British network premiered the series on October 8, 2016. The German Cartoon Network premiered the first two episodes on October 10, 2016. The series premiered in the United States on April 10, 2017. During a fight with Dr. Animo, Ben's Omnitrix accidentally unleashes his self-destruct mode and Ben has to find the Creator of the Omnitrix to turn it off and stop the evil Vilgax. Race Against Time Main article: Ben 10: Race Against Time The second is a live-action film titled Ben 10: Race Against Time,[9] which aired on November 21, 2007. He revolves around Ben, Gwen and Grandpa Max (in another dimension) returning to his hometown of Bellwood and trying to adjust to being normal again. Unfortunately, their lives are once again interrupted by a mysterious alien known as Eon. It premiered on Cartoon Network on November 21, 2007. The film was directed by Alex Winter. The film was nominated for two Society Of Visual Effects Awards: Exceptional Visual Effects in a Miniseries, Film or Special – Dina Benadon, Evan Jacobs, Brent Young, Chris Christman; and Excellent animated character in a live or commercial broadcast program – Brent Young, Michael Smith. In the film, the group encounters a hive of alien nanobots that are controlled by a single consciousness and are using humans as host bodies to take over the world. Ben and his friends work together to stop them. This film is also when Ben unlocks Nanomech. Destroy All Aliens Main Article: Ben 10: Destroy All Aliens A CGI film titled Ben 10: Destroy all Aliens was announced in mid-2011.[12] and released on March 11, 2012 (Asia/Philippines)[13] and on March 23, 2012 (USA). [14] This film had already been under the working title Ben 10: Alien Dimensions. The film was based on the original series, and featured the original voice cast. CGI was animated by Tiny Island Productions in Singapore. Ben 10 Versus the Universe: The Movie On February 19, 2020, Cartoon Network announced that a film based on the reboot of the series, which will now be released on October 10, 2020. Film adaptation On June 14, 2011, producer Joel Silver announced that he, along with Warner Bros. and Dark Castle Entertainment, would be working on a film version of Ben 10. In January 2012, Albert Torres was announced as a screenwriter. In February 2013, Ryan Engle was announced to in Torres' script. Andrew Rona, Steve Richards and Joel Silver were producers. Alex Heineman and Sarah Meyer were executive producers. [19] Since Silver left Warner Bros. and and and Castle joined Universal Pictures, it is not yet known whether Warner Bros. or Universal will release the film. As of July 2019, the film is likely to be cancelled. Special Ben 10/Generator Rex crossover Main article: Ben 10/Generator Rex: Heroes United During the Cartoon Network panel at San Diego Comic-Con 2011, Ben 10 and Generator Rex creators Man of Action announced a special crossover between the Ben 10 series and Generator Rex titled Ben 10/Generator Rex: Heroes United. The forty-minute special aired on November 25, 2011, as an episode of Generator Rex. [20] A comic book based on the special titled Hero Times Two was released on November 30, 2011, as the 65th edition of DC Comics' Cartoon Network: Action Pack. [22] Elements of the Omnitrix franchise The Omnitrix, its Ultimatrix replacement, and the finished version that is the New Omnitrix are the central elements of Ben 10's story. They are all wristwatch-style devices developed by inventor Galvan Azmuth that turns the user into any of the many alien beings (originally 1,000,906, but the number increased by 9 by scanning additional species not originally in the database). Although many see the Omnitrix as a weapon, its true purpose was to allow the beings of the universe to understand each other and resurrect intelligent species that can be extinct. The Omnitrix appears in the first two incarnations of the franchise (Ben 10 and Ben 10: Alien Force), but Ben had to destroy it and use the Ultimatrix in the Ultimate Alien series. The Ultimatrix had most of the same omnitrix functionality, but would allow the user to transform the alien into its Final Shape (as the species and its DNA would evolve in a million-year simulation). In the final episode of Ultimate Alien, Azmuth takes Ben's Ultimatrix and replaces it with the New Omnitrix – the original version has been a prototype. In Ben 10: Omniverse, the Nemetrix, an imitation of the original Omnitrix, is introduced. Unlike the Omnitrix and its successful models, the Nemetrix uses the DNA of the natural predators of sentient alien races that have the sole purpose of hunting Ben. Thus, only an animal can use the Nemetrix, as users of greater intelligence are unable to use it without incurring mental damage. In the Omniverse, Albedo recreates the Ultimatrix using a Polymorphic Crystal to stabilize its transformations, making it so that it can stay in any shape as long as it wants. It also allows it to transform into the Final Forms of its aliens without first transforming into its normal forms. In the Reboot series, Ben's Omnitrix can

increase enhancements to your aliens. In Season 2, your aliens can become Omni-Enhanced with rock-like constructions and energy. However, the enhancements happen randomly. This energy is later revealed to be coming from a new alien species in his Omnitrix, which It has its own form, Shock Rock. In Season 4, Ben unlocks the Omni-Kix feature, which allows him to add armor to his aliens. The Reboot series also introduces the Antitrix, which is wielded by Kevin Levin. The Antitrix allows Kevin to transform into 11 aliens, most of whom are those ben used before, but significantly altered ben's version. Plumbers The Plumbers is an organization composed of human and alien members, each of which has a special badge. All badges carry the intergalactic peace symbol, a green hourglass shape, which is on the Omnitrix's facial plate. Later, in Omniverse, the Plumbers symbol becomes a red dot. In the original series, the Plumbers of the Earth were a secret government organization that protected the universe from any threat. Its main base is located within Mount Rushmore (where the Null Void and Sub-Energy projector were stored), with additional bases located within Fort Knox, the Space Needle, Devils Tower, the Navajo Monument, the Great Dark Swamp, and major cities such as Roswell, New York, New Orleans, Denver, Los Angeles, Chicago, Orlando, and grand rapids. His main opponent was Vilgax. Max Tennyson was a plumber in his youth. Most plumbers on Earth have dissolved; however, some members remain in a semi-active capacity. Knights Forever The Knights Forever are a secret British society formed for the first time during the Middle Ages that is dedicated to collecting and studying alien technology, usually by illegal means. All aliens they capture along the way are dissected and studied, and all humans captured with them are considered useless and eliminated. They also have a robotic dragon that protects one of their castles. It is revealed in Ultimate Alien that the reason for his actions is to fight Diagon, an entity of another dimension that almost conquered the Earth in the Middle Ages if it were not for the immortal founder of the Knights Forever George. When George left them, the Knights Forever began to fragment under several self-styled Forever Kings who turned the duty of their knights into a genocidal policy toward anything alien. Transport Each series has presented some kind of main transport. Wheeled motor vehicles, appearing as normal cars, are equipped with various parts of plumber technology, such as a turbo engine, laser pistols and autopilot. They are often destroyed during the series. Rustbucket and the Rustbucket II is an old trailer that resembles a 1973 GMC motorhome owned by Max Tennyson. Despite being old, and even having been destroyed a few times, Max has great affection for it. The Resolute is the tetrax spacecraft shard The Hammer is the spaceship of Vilgax It is a Galvanic Mechamorph (kind of Upgrade) that can turn into fully operational technology that it has already touched. It merged with the forever knights ship and became space space to Ben's team during the third season of Alien Force. Rustbucket III, a plumberjet that Kevin upgraded with alien technology, later replaced it. Kevin's car is a Dodge Challenger-like muscle car armed with plumber technology, as well as various other alien technologies, including weapons and off-road capabilities. It is the team's main transport in Alien Force and Ultimate Alien. It is damaged or destroyed many times, especially during fights or chase scenes, and Kevin is constantly busy repairing it. In the Omniverse, after Ben destroyed him while aiming for upgrade, Kevin gave it a new look. He painted blue and placed a white circle with the number 11, with only a stripe. The Proto-TRUK is Rook's spaceship and the team's primary transport in the Omniverse. It can turn into a small truck to camouflage itself between the land vehicles. It was later destroyed and its parts were used by Ben 10,000 to build the Cycles of Time. The series received three promotions from McDonald's Happy Meal internationally, as well as one in America in August 2011. [27] The toys are colorful translucent figures of some Omnitrix/Ultimatrix aliens and their Ultimate shapes, with a small photo of Ben inside. The toys of the Alien Force are four rings, each is an alien (Goop, Jetray, Alien X, Chromastone) with characteristics linked with their powers. Comics Developed by Jason Hall, Min G. Flying. kite when he was struck by lightning, gaining the Omnitrix. He used swamp fire to sign the Declaration of Independence. He also used Humongousaur to defeat the British and tear down the home of a high school bully in revenge. He used other alien from Alien Force and Ultimate Alien, where they have his hair and glasses. Also in MAD, a reference to Alien Force was made with a parody of the movie Cowboys & Aliens, with many titles: Cowboys & Aliens, Alien Force, Cowboys & Aliens, Equestrians and Cowboys & Aliens, Silly Bands. The reference was made at first when Jake wakes up with Ben by his side, but with Jake wearing Ben's pants and hat, with the Onnitrix on his wrist. He also used the Omnitrix to become an alien with the mix of Diamondhead, Chromastone, and Big Way to crush a cowboy. In the episode of South Park You're Getting Old, Cartman's mother mentions that Cartman gets upset when she doesn't receive a gift every time someone receives a gift at a party. One of the gifts Cartman receives is a Ben 10 Wrist Rocket. The episode Hurtled from a Helicopter into a Speeding Train shows Ben at his 14th birthday party, where he complains about his gifts given by Azmuth. Ben 10 villains, such as Enoch, Hex and Animo, make a brief appearance in the episode The Apprentice of Van Rook. References to the species of Galvan Prime and Wildvine also appear in Guess who will be dinner? and Eternal, respectively. Both references were made by Secret Scientist Dr. Arthur Beeman, the UFologist of the series. In the Peep Show episode, Man Jam, Jeremy jokingly refers to Ben, the boyfriend of a woman he admires, as Ben 10 during a phone call to him. [31] References in video games Ben 10 is presented as a crossover character in Brawlhalla, a 2D platformfighting game. He appears as his alien form Heatblast, Diamondhead, and Four Arms in the form of crossover skins for certain playable characters.
