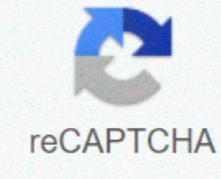

Excerpts from this document... Save the Animals: Stop animal testing Using Animals in research and to test food safety has been the subject of heated debate for decades. According to data collected by F. Barbara Orlans for her book In the Name of Science: Responsible Animal Experiment, sixty percent of all animals used in testing are used in biomedical research and product safety testing (62). People have different feelings for animals; many look at animals as companions, while others see animals as a means to promote medical methods or promote experimental research. However, humans perceive animals, the fact remains that animals are exploited by research institutions and cosmetic companies across the country and around the world. While humans often benefit from successful animal studies, the pain, suffering and death of animals are not worth the possible human benefits. Thus, animals should not be used in research or to test the safety of products. First, animal rights are violated when used in research. Tom Regan, a professor of philosophy at North Carolina State University, argues: Animals have a basic moral right to be treated with respect. ... read on. This test is extremely painful for animals because death can take days or even weeks. According to Orlans, the animals suffer from vomiting, diarrhoea, paralysis, convulsions and internal bleeding. Since death is a necessary endpoint, dying animals do not escape the suffering of euthanasia (154). In his paper entitled Time to Reform Toxic Tests, Michael Balls, Professor of Medical Cell Biology at the University of Nottingham and Chairman of the Trustees of FRAME (Foundation for the Replacement of Animals in Medical Experiments), argues that the LD50 test is scientifically unjustified. The accuracy it is designed to provide is an illusion because of uncontrolled biological variables (31). The use of the Draize test and the LD50 test to study the toxicity of the product has decreased over the past few years, but these tests have not been completely eliminated. Thus, since animals are subjected to excruciating pain, suffering and death when used in laboratory and cosmetic tests, animal studies must be stopped to prevent more animal waste. Finally, testing products on animals is absolutely unnecessary because viable alternatives are available. Many cosmetic companies, for example, have been looking for better ways to test their products without the use of animal subjects. ... read on. Many animals, especially the higher species of mammals, have internal and organs identical to the structures and functions of human internal organs. In addition, animals have feelings, thoughts, goals, needs and desires that are similar to human functions and abilities, and these similarities should be respected, not exploited, because of the selfishness of people. Tom Regan argues that animals are subjects of life just like human beings, and the subject of life has an inherent value. They... ends on their own (qtd. in Orlans 26). Therefore, the life of animals should be respected, as they have an inalienable right to decent treatment. The harm caused to animals should not be minimized because they are not considered human. Finally, animal testing should be eliminated because it violates animal rights, causes pain and suffering to experimental animals, and there are other means of testing the toxicity of the product. People cannot justify improving life for themselves by randomly torturing and performing thousands of animals a year to conduct laboratory experiments or test products. Animals should be treated with respect and dignity, and this right to decent treatment is not supported in the exploitation of animals for selfish purposes. For example, the arthritis drug Vioxx proved safe in animal studies, but was taken off the market in 2004 after causing more than 60,000 deaths in the U.S. alone. Statistics show that every year millions of animals such as dogs, cats, rats, mice, ferrets, hom and monkeys experience physical and mental torture due to scientific practice. While some believe that these experiments are necessary on the basis of the development of medicine, most people believe that these experiments are cruel, unethical barbaric and outdated. One of the biggest drawbacks identified in animal testing is harm, imprisonment and pain. During the experiments, the animals used are forced to inhale or swallow huge amounts of test substances that are often toxic and poisonous. In addition, animals are used in experiments, not humans. This means that any test results may or may not be beneficial to humans. If the results are called useless, then without a reason the animal would suffer. This is because animals have different genes, proteins and metabolic pathways from humans. While it is true that these experiments help improve science, they also hinder medical development. For example, in previous years, patient studies have found a link between cancer and tobacco use. Many scientists believe this to be true, as extremely convincing evidence supports this link. However, during animal testing, tobacco repeatedly did not produce cancer in the subjects. Because failed, warnings about the dangers of cigarettes were rejected for years. Animal rights advocates argue that the act of animal testing is unnecessary and cruel. Most of these supporters believe, testing on animals is just like sexism or racism. In the view of these defenders, all living beings deserve respect and should not suffer for any reason considered morally wrong. In addition, the zookeeper opposes animal experiments, citing the fact that humans do not have the right to use animals because they do not have the consent of animals. Finally, animal testing should not be allowed because it causes suffering to the subjects. Its human benefit has not been proven, and most of the benefits derived from experiments can be produced by other means.
