The castle and auxiliary buildings that supported the castle life ranged from the castle to the castle. By rotating, these two sets form 260 unique combinations of the name and number of the day. For example, when the cycle of names of the day ends at 7 Ajaw, the names of the day begin again in Imix, and the numbers continue: 8 Imix', 9 Ik', 10 Ak'b'al and so on. These gears rotate until the final combination is snapped into place at 13 Ajaw, marking the end of the year. It's easy to see the Mayans put Tzolk on the calendar. For example, they believed that your date of birth determines the qualities you show in your personality - just as some people believe your atropic mark these days. Holy men also schedule certain events all year round based on Thololik's calendar. At the beginning of each uinal (20-day period), the shaman counted forward to determine when religious and ceremonial events would take place. He then chose the dates that would be the wealthiest or luckiest in the community. Despite countless functions, the Tzolk'in calendar was still unable to measure the solar year, a time that lasts until the sun's perfect cycle. This is why the Mayans needed a more accurate calendar to follow a whole year we keep in a whole year.
