Evolutionary biologist Richard Dawkins, known for his popular books on science and atheism, coined the term in his 1976 book *The Selfish Gene*. The word itself is a combination of gene and a Greek word for imitation, and he argued that culture was the means of transmission. Decades later, we are awash in entertaining and influential memes thanks to internet culture. The BBC recently wrote about how memes are crucial in our daily lives, carrying news, ideas and humor in a clever little package. Memes can help us relax on serious topics. They also spread like jokes to give us a humorous point of view. Iconic meme stars usually get the role unexpectedly, and as world-famous Grumpy Cat they can capture our hearts. It's not surprising, then, that cat memes are so popular that some business owners make a good live trade with them. These memes evolved into books and picture-a-day calendars, where cats provide commentary about their lives that we can all relate. A meme is a virally transmitted image embellished with text, usually sharing pointed comments about cultural symbols, social ideas, or current events. Decades Decades Dawkins supported the appropriation of the word meme in the digital world. He said the new meaning is not that far from his original explanation. Memes used to be the domain of 20-somethings. But Internet users of all ages and all levels of digital savviness have adopted memes to express their feelings. Memes are a worldwide social phenomenon. The more a meme resonates with people, the more they will share it and the longer it will spread. Memes are usually funny, but often that humor is injected with wry political or social commentary. Sometimes memes are available for shock value or to teach a life lesson. Other times a single photo or short video will generate hundreds of hilarious interpretations. Sometimes a meme will be appreciated by only a select group of people, and other times a meme will have almost universal appeal. Here's a look at some popular meme categories and examples to give you a better idea of the breadth and scope of these viral statements. A meme can be a still image photograph or an animated GIF, as long as the content appeals to others in a divisible format. Popular memes are often funny, ranging from goofy humor to niche humor to more pointed political humor. Children, parenting, pets and everyday life offer endless meme materials. Often a funny image spurs a variety of memes, which with this determined-looking toddler tie their hand in a fist. The above meme mimics our determination on New Year's Eve to finally make positive changes. The same image represents our feelings of satisfaction and winning

when we get an unexpected unexpected. As in the above example, the phrase Meanwhile in ... has created a lot of memes that show what life is like elsewhere. Another conversational meme tackles the challenge of Change My Mind: Other conversational memes include: events provide endless meme feed, feed, humor that sometimes pointed, sometimes stupid, and sometimes painful. As in the above meme, the COVID-19 pandemic and its subsequent social isolation period generated thousands of memes, capitalizing on the dark humor of a shared experience.
