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## How do i change the audio output on my samsung tv

The 3.5mm jack is a fixed audio output input, not a headphone jack and has not been controlled by TV volume controls. So external speakers will need amplifier volume control. --HDTech - Collapse - OK... I realized in the 1st hand that the 3.5mm audio output is not adjustable using Samsung Smart TV volume up/down. however, I wonder if optical audio output is adjustable???? I can't test this with my current audio equipment; However, I know that you can purchase an optical sound rca converter adapter (for ~\$15) that would allow me to do so. thanks in advance! - Collapse - I would also like to know the answer to Question. I couldn't control the volume until I connected the amplifier, receiver, or headphones with volume control.... Loren - Collapse - univ. remote control w / LEARNING, if the speaker is controlled, so I tried optical on Samsung (different models UN40EH5300) and it is constant as well. Stupid. In any case, another option - if your other devices (such as a cable box, external speaker system, etc.) are not UHF - is to purchase a universal remote control with a learning option, such as the Sony RM-VL600. in other words, if your external speaker system can be controlled by a remote control, but you don't want to deal with multiple remote controls to control your TV, cable box, external speaker system... however, the remote controls you have (e.g. cable universal remote control) cannot control all your devices, and you can get a universal remote control that can record the output of that remote control for which there is no code. I have yet to find a universal remote control (less than a few \$100) that can learn UHF though, which is not very common yet, but comcast is starting to use its X1 boxes. - Collapse – I can't control the sound out lt sucks I just replaced my Sony TV with a Samsung Smart and just realized I can't control the sound out! I decided to hook up the audio tape only to discover there is no variable audio output. I tried an optical and headphone jack with the same result. The soundbar is Visio and I don't think the TV remote will control it. I don't understand why Samsung didn't make the output variable. I am a very passionate fan of Samsung and have been satisfied with my electronics, but if I can not find a solution the TV will have to come back. Also, since this is samsung standard, I will have to go with another brand. Are there other options here? - Collapse - Sorry Samsung, I have to return my TV. I have a Samsung J5200 Series 43 UN43J5200AF. I just got off the phone with Samsung support and he checked the information in this thread. It is very disappointing that Samsung did not provide this basic feature. It seems obvious to me that people want to be able to control the volume of their external speakers via the TV remote. This TV is coming back. I hope that TVs from other manufacturers have smarter features. - Collapse - Does Samsung have a handle with external volume control? It's amazing to see that this thread about not being able to control the volume on devices connected to the headphone jack on Samsung TVs goes back to 2010. I just discovered (and I can confirm) that this strange omission has not yet been resolved by Samsung. m 2016. I learned this by buying a new UN50J6200 Smart TV only to find there is no way to control the volume of anything connected to the audio output jack – such as a headphone or powered speaker system that doesn't have its own control or remote control. I would blame myself for not checking in advance, but who would think that such a basic necessity could be missed by a major brand, despite many complaints online over at least 6 years? Also, the email guide or product descriptions don't say you can't control the volume, which seems a bit deceptive to me. I'm not really springing the receiver or wireless headphones that it works for me. This not very smart TV is coming back to Amazon. - Collapse - I read a poor manual (Samsung, you need to do better!) and it did not mention any settings to control the volume of that output. If Samsung can't provide a good guide, it's as bad as putting a poor product. - Collapse – Samsung UN32J5500AFXZA Uncontrollable Profits We have just bought a Samsung UN32J5500AFXZA and there is no way to control the volume of external speakers. Samsung has been aware of this problem for a long time. Even worse is the volume is not standard when you go from TV to something like Youtube. Decibels go a LOT when going to Youtube. Imagine if your young child is connected to headphones to the socket. They sit there watching a TV show and decide to change to Youtube and I guarantee you with their eardrums going to take a hit. I called Samsung support last night and they said you need headphones with volume control. In addition to the fact that 99% of the headphones sold do not have volume control, there is a question of uncontrolled profit. The volume of your headphones can be set to a comfortable listening level, but when you change to Youtube, your drums will still be beaten. It's dangerous and as much as I don't like costumes, I think the class action is waiting. Millions of these kits are out there and Samsung making TVs with uncontrolled profits is dangerous. Perhaps this will force Samsng to change that jack and allow volume control to work. I am marked by the not so poor engineering of these kits. - Collapse - TV variable audio outputs Digital and Analog (NO) I recently purchased 6 Flat screen TVs. two 65 and four 55 Requirement were TV tuner ATSC, Quam, HDMI and VGA inputs and variable audio outputs with decent speakers in each set. VGA input was not a transaction breaker, but variable sound was/is. Each TV must be equipped with a pair of speakers that can be controlled by a TV remote control. I use Tannoy i5 and i6 speakers. I did things like going to the shops with headphones to confirm that the outputs are variable (no) and I spent hours online reading PDF TV manuals. I was told the guy that I need to buy at the NEC because this is a professional grade TV and they are all in and out of it that I In fact, the nec TV 1080P kit is all underwhelming and will cost about \$400.00 more than the 4K Samsung. His information and even a manual list that the TV has digital and analog outputs. The TV is displayed and O only looks like a digital optical output. I have an optical analog converter but couldn't give myself to pay \$25.00 to Best Buy for an optical cable, so I'm looking forward to UPS bringing in the \$6.00 optical cables I ordered online. The company that sold me NEC TV will allow me to return the TV and now its down to what set I rip apart to add variable audio outputs. I know that TV produces trying to save every penny, but it's like selling a car without a radio. The sad part is that as television broadcasters try to greatly improve the audio experience and quality of their broadcast TV producers are doing their best to trash that effort. It happened on AM radio years ago. The receiver produces reduced radio audio so much that the broadcasters' final was an attitude that its only AM why bother. TV with good sound can be a very positive viewing experience (The Voice), it would be sad if we all just gave up because the sound of the receivers is so poor. Without a single TV. - Collapse – I wish you a top posted on this. As you may or may not know the studio is trying to close the analog hole and thus take a break from what you are looking for. - Collapse – NOT DAO volume control for my TVs, but for the new Samsungs I just approved NO volume control (even via Digital Audio Out-RCA Converter or using XFINITY box) on my 51st and 32st Samsung TVs: PN51D430 & UN32J4000. I was told that the new Samsung has remote DAO volume control, but unfortunately not mine. Plan to add a jack from the internal speaker (I'm a former NASA engineer). Any advice? And nothing on the packaging, product description Samsung or Amazon, e-manual, or the TV itself explains that you can not control the volume from the sound from the socket. - Collapse – Finally decided to upgrade its now half-decade Sony 720p LCD TV. Went with Samsung Smart TV and thought I had updated, only to run on the same problem as everyone in this thread complains. I liked the simplicity that my JBL active subwoofer connected to the variable (and fixed, never knew I could replace it even) RCA outputs on my Sony TV, worked flawlessly and beautifully, without having to have 2-3 remote controls. Ironically one of the reasons I decided to upgrade was to remove sony remote + Roku remote control, so clearly I'm not going to get a separate audio system. Also in my case, I did not but for TV programming I just use an OTA antenna (happen to be on the hill and area with 50+ OTA HD channels). So, I'm seriously considering considering what this guy is telling you about here: I would like to use something like this: enough and with added benefit adjustments. I'm just soldering it to RCAs that are audio input (for the composite), and leave it as such, I don't expect them to be needed, or just soldering it directly to 3.5mm that can actually make more sense. I know it's not ideal for sound quality, but in my specific subwoofer need, I'm not too worried about sound quality being too distorted.Comments? - Collapse - \$160 (minimum cost) solution I bought a separate fairly inexpensive 2.1 reinforced speaker system with (yet another) remote control. You connect to RCA or optical output on Samsung. That doesn't take Samsung off the hook obviously because of the cost and additional equipment, but it sounds good. - Collapse – Doing additional research I ran through this BT info: that doesn't work for my Samsung, but this procedure: pull menus on my TV but I have flair for my TV not having BT hardware, or else I would like to try BT KB. Maybe someone with a slightly larger model than I could try what's shown in the first video, if it works, I could see myself using my sub with a BT adapter. - Collapse - Request for correction from Samsung Today I sent an email to Samsung linking the potential danger to children. A small child can listen through headphones, change the TV mode to YouTube and an unusually large volume change that happens can damage their ears. There is no warning in the manual. I think the whole class of people has been sold a dangerous product and can be a matter of responsibility, and I want to correct it. I'm sick of manufacturers putting out poorly engineered products. This TV should be able to maintain the same volume under all circumstances. - Collapse - This is a copy and paste from my particular (relatively low-end) model on auto volume• Auto Volume Try NowWhen you change channels, video sources or content, automatic volume automatically adjusts the TV volume level so that the volume level remains the same for all sources. For example, if you switch a streaming video program to a Blu-ray Player or your favorite TV channel, the auto volume can change the volume to 12db to smooth out the volume. The auto-volume feature has two settings: Normal and Night. The normal volume control level is normal. The night has a slightly lower volume level and is ideal for watching late-night TV. To use the volume control on the connected source device to control the volume, turn off Auto Volume. When you use automatic volume with the source device, the device's volume control may functioning properly. - Collapse – This is from the SOny website – maybe I should have bought Sony. Or maybe all TV companies have found a way to save \$10 and don't have variable output to slots? What is the difference between FIXED and VARIABLE audio output? The AnswerThe FIXED or VARIABLE audio output setting changes the way audio is recording through the AUDIO OUT jacks on your TV. FIXED: When this setting is selected, the SOUND of the TV through the AUDIO OUT sockets does not change using the volume buttons on the TV's remote control. The sound is fixed on one level. VARIABLE: When this setting is selected, the SOUND of the TV changes through the AUDIO OUT jack when the volume button on the TV remote control is used. The sound depends on the signals sent from the TV remote control. - Collapse - I just got a Samsung 60KS7005 and have the same problems and tried I finally found a solution until the TV offers HDMI (Bow) I tried different solutions including HDMI (Arc) analog RCA and 3.5mm converters, and it gives me audio, but I can not control the volume, and it's just not good enough. So I continued to search and finally find a product called Ligawo 6518777 on eBay (and amazon.de) I just ordered it and didn't get it yet, so I can't say for sure it will work yet, but I'll update when I know it. However, this converter is assumed to be able to convert audio form HDMI (Arc) to RCA and 3.5mm audio. . and it also supports volume control! (I really hope this will work because I have bought many different things that should work, but not so far) If this works, you should get an audio recording, and also when you change the volume of the TV, it should control the volume as the entire receiver would do, but at a cheaper price. Page 2 I have been looking for the same solution for many years. Read many forums, all I could find was custom made panels that could do it. Recently I stumbled upon this device, which looked promising. According to the description, the requirement seemed to be sufficient. I ordered it and it arrived in 15 or 20 days. As soon as I connected, there was a lot of background noise and I was dissapointed. I changed my position and the noise reduced, so I changed the 3.5mm male to 3.5mm male connector, which I use between the TV and amp, the noise disappeared. I've been using it for the last 2 weeks, acting like charm, volume control and mute, just what I need.
