On September 15, 2008, New York began issuing improved driver's licenses that comply with WHTI. DMV allows business partners the chance to process and issue plates, allowing decals and boards, among others. The title of a vehicle establishes an individual person or a business, as a legal operator of the vehicle, and each U.S. State has different procedures for obtaining this type of certification. When a sale/purchase of a vehicle takes place, the title must be transferred to the new owner, unless there is a financed purchase, in which case the owner remains the same until the payment is completed, so the titration is transferred to the new owner. When this documentation is lost, the owner can request a copy in the State where the title was issued. The data we can find in this documentation are: Identification Number, vehicle brand, year of production, license plate number, owner details and, if in doubt at the moment, the data of the person to whom the money is owed. In the United States, vehicle plates or plates usually have between 5 and 7 characters, depending on the state where the plate is being issued you can find different alphanumeric combinations. There are also different plates issued by the State Department to those who are entitled to it. These plates can rely on a letter (representing the State is issued), plus two letters (representing the country code) and then three or four random numbers. Or well, four numbers, two letters to identify the country and another letter to identify the state where it is issued. This is the case for the identification of plates issued for UN vehicles. In the U.S. there is a law called the Commercial Vehicle Safety Act, which establishes the requirements that a state must comply with when issuing a Commercial License. Before 1992, the year this license was implemented, the requirements varied according to the state, as commercial vehicles required special skills and knowledge.
