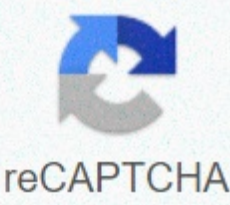

Adequacy screening identifies candidates who have the skills, skills and qualifications needed to perform specific jobs at the Post Office. On the other hand, the screening process was designed to disqualify ineligible or inappropriate candidates. Proper execution of the screening process will do the following: In addition to having the necessary skills and abilities, potential employees must have personal qualifications consistent with the characteristics of sections 512.11 to 512.14. Applicants must meet the following criteria: Applicants must meet the following criteria: Applicants must meet the following criteria: The sequence of fitness activities in 512.21 and 512.22 is designed to conserve time and speed up the screening process. An overview of other screening activities is at 512.23 to 512.26. Nothing in this section should be interpreted to prevent the Post Office from taking action based on false information given during the screening process. The purpose of the pre-employment guidance is to provide applicants whose position on the pre-hire list is such that they will be considered for employment within a reasonable time an opportunity to become more familiar with the jobs for which they could receive future consideration. Applicants are scheduled for a pre-employment guidance session composed of but not limited to the following activities: Employees responsible for hiring will establish a pre-employment investigation file for each applicant that meets all of the following: The pre-employment investigative file is the repository of all documents collected in the pre-allotment guidance, information obtained during suitability screening, and investigative results recorded in the Interview Sheet and Checklist (Exhibit 512.222 pages 1 and 2). Hiring staff will complete and sign the Post-Offer Checklist (Exhibit 512.22, page 3). Records that are kept in the preemployment investigation files are described below and are retained for five years and then sent to the Federal Records Center for another five years (see Manual AS-353, Appendix. E, USPS 100,100 for details): The following records are collected, reviewed and stored electronically: Form PS 2591, Job Application, including supplemental application forms and any applicant statements adding to the original applications. Form PS 2181-A, Preemployment Screening - Authorization and Release. Form PS 2181-B, Applicant Drug Test — Consent and Release. Ps Form 2181-D, Disclosure and Disclosure for Consumer Reports and Consumer Investigative Report. Police records (state, municipal and local) and correspondence to and from police departments. summaries of state departments of motor vehicles. Automotive mechanical bench test results, qualification review panel evaluation, qualification, test, or other requirements. It's just the first step of numerous you need to go through to get jobs with the Post Office. What happens after usps is pre-contracted? It automatically triggers your background check, you can get an interview and the PM can trigger a drug test. They send it to the HRSSC and send back a job offer with the names listed, to the PM or ICO. If your name is on this list, you'll receive an email or a call. What does pre-screening mean for USPS work? Pre-rental means that you have passed your background screening and drug testing, and should receive emails saying when to get into orientation. Pre-screening is the stage where drug testing and background checks are done. If pre-screening is crossed, an individual will be listed as pre-contracted. What is the pre-hiring process? Pre-hiring procedures are those that are performed before a job offer is made to a proposed employee. Hiring an inappropriate person can be very expensive for an employer, so companies follow these procedures to help them better recognize qualified applicants. While an approval score is 70 or more, USPS ranks candidates based on their score.
