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## Hampton bay caswyck ceiling fan installation manual

Along with giving light to a room, ceiling fans circulate cool air in summer and provide warmth by pushing warm air down in winter. This dual purpose makes the ceiling fan an attractive addition to any home. Although ceiling fans are usually easy to install on their own, there are a few steps you should follow to ensure proper installation. If you have existing light fixtures, then installing a ceiling fan is easy because the cable is already done. However, make sure the electric box is replaced if it is not judged to hang a ceiling fan. You can usually find this by looking for the ranking sticker in the box. That being said, before you do anything make sure all the electricity to the box is turned off. With the power off, remove the old lights and remove all existing wires. Try your best to avoid cord cutting. Instead, simply rotate the plastic connector at the end of the wire. Step 2 – Disconnect the Old Electric Box Now that the cable has disconnected, completely disconnect the old power box. This can be tricky, especially if the old box was previously nailed to the joist. If so, then use a hammer to pry the box free of walls. With the box removed, it's time to install a new box. Hold the new box up to the existing hole and make sure it fits correctly. If not, then track around the edges and cut drywall with a saw to ensure fit. If the fan is equipped with a fan stand, then attach braces before inserting a new box into the hole. Step 3 – Feed Through The Wires Into The Box Before you screw in the new box, make sure all the electrical wires are fed. Once this is done, you can place a new box in the hole and screw it into the joist. Remember, it's this bracket that holds the fan in place, so make sure the fan is securely attached to the ceiling before moving forward. Step 4 – Attach Ceiling Medallion Some fans come up with medals that add decorative pieces to the fan. Once the box is secured to the ceiling, glue the ceiling medallion into place using adhesive beads. If you plan to paint medals of different colors then be sure to do this before installing them on the ceiling. Make sure all cables are not caught between the medallion and the ceiling by running it through the center. Fasten the medallion into place with screws, which must be pushed with the head of the nail and to match the ceiling. Step 5 – Install ceiling plate once medallion has been installed, it's time to install metal ceiling plate. Again, run the cable all the way plates and screws into the electric box to secure it. Step 6 – Run the Cable Through the Canopy Place main fan unit on a flat surface and make sure the cable of the motor is open through the center of the canopy. Next, turn the bottom bar pipe onto the motor and use the wrend to tighten it in place. When running cables, make sure they are not destroyed in any way and and placed clean through the canopy. Step 7 – Connect the Home Cable To the Main Motor's Take Fan Cable and connect the canopy to the ceiling plate. It is best to simply connect one side up to the plate, then use a wire connector to connect the cable from the ceiling to the one you pull from the motor in the last step. Follow the instructions in the fan manual when connecting the home cable to the fan cable. Once this is done, securely attach the other side to the ceiling plate. Make sure the cable fits into the box. Otherwise, you should use a wire cutter to cut the cable to the desired length. With the motor in place it's time to connect the fan blades. Follow the instructions included with the fan by attaching each knife with the supplied screws. Then, plug the fan light into the cable hanging on the bottom of the motor. Make sure you install additional colors and light bulbs per the instruction manual. Once everything is installed, turn the power back on and test the fan. It can be a hard combination to find. While air conditioning window units dramatically lower the temperature, they also dramatically increase your power bill. Ceiling fans have long been used as a smart way to deal with rooms that are too hot or too cold. During the hot months, the fan draws air to the ceiling, preventing warm air from building up near the floor. During the colder months, ceiling fans can be diverted to rotate in the same direction push the warm air as high as the ceiling down closer to the floor. Best of all, unlike air conditioning, ceiling fans don't run energy-hungry compressors, so it costs very little to operate. Ceiling fans replace existing ceiling lights usually located in the center of the room. If you already have ceiling lights, this is a direct job. You should be able to work over your head on the stairs for a long time, and you must have basic wiring skills of the level required to install ceiling lights. If you don't have ceiling lights, this project is much more difficult because you need to run the power cord to the middle of the ceiling. If that's the case, help from an electrician and perhaps a professional drywall job may be required to complete the project. Contact your local building department to see if permission is required for ceiling fan installation, for the electrical part of the project, or for both tasks. In the electrical service panel, turn off the circuit breaker that controls the power flowing to the ceiling light. Place the stairs six feet under the light, slightly to the side. Removes shadows and bulbs. With a cordless drill, remove the lamp but not yet the cable. With the voltage tester, double check that no wires are on. If the wires are not on, turn off the plastic wire nuts from the wire locks. Untwist's a lockle. Set the lights aside. The ceiling fan stand allows you to install an electric box between two ceiling joist without the need to access the attic. When you purchase this item, make sure it's called retrofit, old-work, or fan brace remodel. One of these terms indicates that attic access is not required. With the inventor of the stud, find a place that is equally centered between two buttons and about 6 inches from the existing ceiling box. Wearing eye protection and a dust mask, cut a hole in the place with a 4-inch hole saw. Reach into the hole and clean the ceiling area above the insulation drywall and debris. First, insert a separate clamp part into the hole, with the foot touching the top of the ceiling drywall. Then turn the stand by hand until the buffer is elongated and perfectly matched between the two joists. You may need to use the wrend for the last turn to firmly sit the stand between the joists. Remove the electric wire from the old ceiling box and pull it through the new hole. Insert the wire into the box including a retrofit clamp through one of the knock-out holes inside the box. Attach the box to a buffer with the included hardware. With all the wires removed from the old box, round cover plate 4 inches above the box. These plates are usually white but they can be painted, if you will. Or, if the old box is solely supported by drywall, you may be able to and patch holes. If the old box is nailed to the joist side, it is difficult to remove without removing a large part of the drywall; in this case, leave the box in place and cover it with a plate. Almost all ceiling fans are installed in two steps: first the mounting bracket is mounted on the electric box, then most ceiling fans slip into place in the mounting bracket. This eliminates the need to hold the heavy ceiling fan motor assembled overhead while simultaneously trying to screw it into place. The mounting bracket can be mounted long-stepped into the canopy (decorative cover). If so, remove the bracket from the canopy, unless otherwise directed by the instructions. Bracket screws are attached into the electric box with the supplied screws. Make sure that the power supply cable (the cable that previously turned on the ceiling light) passes the intended opening in the mounting bracket. Slide the fan canopy onto the fan motor assembly. Since this is a ring, this must be done before assembling the fan motor attached to the electric box. Stand on a six-foot ladder and with the help, slide the fan motor assembly into the mounting bracket until it sits down. Use the hardware provided to secure the assembly of the fan motor. Leave the fan bar unbound for now. See ceiling fan instructions for cable details specific to your fan. Hire an electrician at this time if you feel uncomfortable with this procedure. Exposing the wire ends with a wire stripper and twisting it along with the wire beans usually included in the ceiling fan kit. Slide the fan canopy up and screw into place with decorative screws from the kit. Your ceiling fan blades may come in two parts: a seat and a knife. The seat is a metal part that attaches the blade to the assembly of the fan motor. Attach the knife to the seat, then attach them to the ceiling fan. Exactly with this step due to any deviations can cause the fan blades to vibrate. If your ceiling fan includes light components, end your installation by adding a light bulb and a light color. Turn on the circuit breaker again. Go back to the ceiling fan and test it out. It.

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
