To keep in touch with each other and alert others to the dangers of the road (and the police), truckers use Citizens (CB) radio. CB radio was invented by Al Goss in 1945. At the time, it was mainly used by workers such as carpenters and plumbers, or by small businesses. Then, in 1960, it became more accessible for anyone to own. CB radio use grew in popularity in the 1960s with nearly 500,000 licensed CB users since 1963. It then soared into widespread use in the 1970s. What really caused a huge increase in CB radio usage was during the 1973 energy crisis. To help with natural gas conservation, the U.S. federal government had implemented a 55 mph speed limit on highways. With CB radios, truckers could give each other a head up for gas stations and if there were any smokey bears (police) wandering around as they had to still make their destinations on time. In addition to alerting fellow truckers, CB radios were a way to be less alone on the road and pass the time on what may be some monotonous driving on the highway. And although we're now in the age of smartphones and using apps like Waze and Trucker Tools to warn other drivers about accidents and cops, many truckers still use CB radios.
