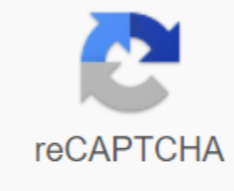

Vandersloot, who founded this company in 1987 in a village, Idaho. Over the past 30 years, the company has grown into a giant of up to \$2 billion and operated in nearly 20 countries around the world. In other words, the Company is a multilevel marketing company and works in a health and wellness niche. Honestly, if you explore this niche, there are thousands of popular brands out there and the market is completely saturated. Few other popular are Amway, doTerra and Nerium. Melaleuca Product Line The company has more than 400 products created by scientists and is the largest consumer packaging manufacturer in Northwest America. Just let me introduce you to some categories: Nutrition Medicine cabinet Beauty Hair Care Household Bath & Body Home Fragrances Essential Oils Cosmetics Home Cleaning Etc... Melaleuca aims to improve three areas of life: i). To improve your health, the company has manufactured wellness products, supplements, functional foods, nutrients and breakthrough innovations. These products naturally and successfully manage weight, increase nutrition and promote health. ii). Your environment Although very few companies perform their social responsibilities, Melaleuca is always a leader in improving our environment with non-toxic home cleaners. Objects are harmless to your home and allow you to live cleanly without the dangers of harsh and corrosive chemicals. Melaleuca promotes concentrated products that require less water, less fuel and less plastic to be packaged. iii). Finances Melaleuca is an MLM company and offers you the opportunity to reduce your debt and increase your monthly income. However, you need to recruit people for this business to make money. I will look into this option in more detail in a matter of seconds. What do people say about their products? Despite its ability to operate in a saturated market, its growth over the years has strengthened the quality of its products. It's subjective because you see people with different perspectives on their products, but overall I can say that their products are much better than most other MLM companies on the market. It is not my only opinion, it is supported by many people who have already used its products. Let's take a look at a few: Melaleuca is an MLM company, and the only way to make money from this scheme is either to sell products to earn a retail premium or to recruit other individuals to earn from their compensation plan. But before you start, you have to pay \$29 and become their independent marketing director, a term they use to describe distributors. Basically, you're like buying an affordable franchise that offers you the right to resell its products. Then you make a reward based on the products sold. Melaleuca compensation plan The compensation plan is very confusing and complicated. However, I will try to make it as simple as possible. You can earn 2 income types, i.e. rewards and bonuses. Let's take one at a time. Rewards You can earn rewards from people who have either signed up and registered from people registered by others. If you register a customer, you can earn two types of rewards: Product Presentation Commission – When you register a customer, you will receive 50% of the product price for purchases during the customer's first month. Personal customer commissions – Starting in the customer's second month, you will receive purchases from all customers you personally register. The monthly reward you receive depends on how many active personally registered customers you have during that month. If others register a customer, you will earn Organizational Commissions - You will receive 7% commissions purchased by your subline (7 levels deep) and registered by others. Bonuses Bonus – Status is 49, and every time you move on you earn an advance bonus. Pacesetter Bonus – After completing the Independent Marketing Executive app and agreement on your registration or the following month, you are eligible for this program – As your personal enrollees progress to the next status, you can earn Bonus. Core Mentoring Bonus (CMB) – Managers 3 and above can earn a core mentoring bonus as other members of your core organization move from one space to another. Double Core Mentoring Bonus – Whenever a manager 3 or a parent retains 2. Leadership Growth Bonus – It earns when you reach senior director status or above and have new growth at your level 7 deep in line over two months, generating an average of 30 or more lead points or more. 20/20 Bonus – this was when you registered 20 active primary customers over 5 months you earn a one-time bonus of \$500. Monthly car bonus - The company pays for a new car when you reach senior executive status, and it costs two new cars when you reach executive, national and corporate director status. Melaleuca has been accredited with the Better Business Bureau since 1987 and has grades A+. I'm just mentioning that BBB is a reliable site to get company data, and it's not easy for companies to get A+ ratings. Even the Company has maintained this rating for more than 30 years. The rating does not mean that the Company is a viable opportunity, but is intended to tell you how many complaints have been received and how the company has resolved these complaints. Another thing to comment on Melaleuca is that it is a business for over 30 years. Working in this business for so long is a miracle. You are always under FTC observation, and in the past you can see examples of MOBE and Digital Height that did not last longer than six years. 3. Pretty Good Products As I have previously stated that the company has very decent products and it is very surprising that the MLM company offers it. However, I haven't said that their compensation plan is also good because its only focus is to recruit people, and I don't recommend you choose this path. As for buying the company's products, I haven't found too many problems with their quality. To retain your membership in the company, you must spend at least \$35 per month. Even if you are unable to register people in the system, you will have to pay for this. Even I have read complaints about people who find it difficult to cancel their membership after using their credit cards. This is a big red flag for this company. If you lose your card and your bank account is compromised, don't even bother calling them, they'll charge you regardless. There are a lot of complaints about poor customer service online. Either they don't listen to you or if they do, but they don't offer you any solution. If you ask for your membership to be revoked, they will ask you for a lengthy cancellation policy and charge your credit card unless it is eventually cancelled. Don't wait up cancel your membership before 2-3 months. It simply means that you will also be charged for that month. It's bad tactics and the only purpose for these delaying tactics is to make more money. 3. Massive complaints against BBB have been registered with BBB against 152 complaints. It's way too much. If you see the types of complaints, the majority have problems with their products and billing. Such a large number of complaints should not be allowed to go blind in our eyes. I have worked for many popular MLM companies and found it difficult to convince people to join these sites. This is also the case with Melaleuca. Simply on one side the products are expensive compared to competitors' prices and on the other side they offer no value. This problem is common for the entire MLM industry, see zurvita, Juice Plus+, Monat Global and Kyani, a few. People don't join them because of their products, but their only purpose to join these sites is to make money recruiting other people. The products are pure rubbish, so it is very difficult for their members to convince other people to buy them. Fortunately, we have Melaleuca with a pretty decent product line. Like most MLM companies, they have merit and disadvantages. The company offers good products that are also in demand for health-conscious people. Melaleuca also allows people to participate in its business model and earn a reward to promote their products to other people. Legal I do not recommend that you start this as an income source. Can Melaleuca become your dairy cow and give you that it promises? I wouldn't believe it, but that's just my opinion. There are easier options when it comes to making money online. Before we look at whether or not Melaleuca is a pyramid scheme, we first understand what a pyramid scheme is. Everyone has a different perspective, but I think the company needs to have the following characteristics, called the pyramid scheme. The pyramid scheme doesn't offer the right products for sale. However, they may claim to be selling the product, but often use the product to hide their pyramid structure. Is your money based on the number and sales of people you recruit to them or vice versa? For that, it's a pyramid scheme. If we look at Melaleuca, it has over 400 products that people already use every day. That's why it's not a pyramid scheme. Although Melaleuca is a legitimate MLM company, I can only recommend you to use their products as I have heard a lot of good news about them. However, if you make money, focus on your own online business instead of working for someone else. There, I recommend my favorite business model called affiliate marketing, which is the only method I recommend making money online. Let's look at the reasons why I prefer affiliate marketing to MLM. Unlike Melaleuca, you don't have to recruit anyone to make money. It gives you control and ownership that Melaleuca doesn't have to be involved in face-to-face marketing.
