Routine elective surgeries are scheduled Monday through Thursday, with check-in time between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m. We also only offer vaccination appointments that are scheduled with one of our technicians. Clinic Hours Monday & amp; Wednesday from 8am to 6pm Tuesday & amp; Thursday 8am-9pm Friday from 8am to 5pm Saturday 9am-12pm If you have any questions or comments about our services, call our hospital manager, Ben, at 530-758-5650. A doctor is available for emergencies during hospital hours. After hospital hours, don't drive to the hospital. Call the regular hospital phone number, 850-477-6225, for emergency instructions. Customers must make pre-appointments for everyone except emergency surgery. Most surgical patients will spend 24 hours in the hospital from the time they are admitted until they are released. To protect everyone's pet, we require that your animal's vaccinations be current before they are admitted for elective operations. Specific handouts are available for routine and post operations. Dogs minimum age for elective surgeries:Dog spay – 6 monthsDog neuter – 6 docking – ideally 3-7 daysDewclaw removal – ideally, 3-7 daysCats – minimum age for elective operations:Cat spay – 6 6 neuter – 7 monthsCat de-claw – 3 monthsSpay: A spay is a complete ovario hysterectomy in female cats and dogs. It is a large operation, requiring general anesthesia with minimal risk. Cats and dogs usually feel fine the day after surgery and require no special care except checking the stitches twice a day and returning to Scenic Hills Veterinary Hospital for adhesion removal eight to 10 days after surgery. There are many benefits to steriling your pets. They cannot become pregnant and will not attract male cats/dogs. Stylized animals cannot develop uterine infections, uterine tumors or ovarian tumors. The risk of breast cancer has been greatly reduced. Generally, stylized animals make better pets and usually live longer. Neuter: An inseal is the removal of the testicles in male cats and dogs. Castrating cats and dogs is a small operation requiring general anesthesia with minimal risk. Both cats and dogs usually feel fine the day after the operation.

Dogs have stitches that need to be checked twice a day and should be sent back to Scenic Hills Veterinary Hospital for adhesion removal eight to 10 days after surgery. There are no stitches involved in a cat being inseal and generally no follow-up is required. There are many benefits to neuting pets; they are less likely to fight, roam, get lost or be hit by a car. Castering removes the sex drive and prevents sexual frustration, plus helps to prevent prostatitis and prostate cancer. The main advantage of castration is that the neutered males cannot blame unwanted puppies or kittens. Declawing cats is a small operation requiring general anesthesia with minimal risks and only minimal temporary discomfort with our procedures. Bathing is often very stressful for cats, and even some dogs. Flea control can be easily and effectively achieved without bathing the animal. Milk, ice, ice, foods and greasy foods should be fed for about six months; this will vary with the specific breed, so ask the veterinarian. Larger breeds generally switch to adult dog food when they reach a weight of about 25 pounds.
