

To download an MP3 file to your Macintosh computer, review and click download the MP3 file option, and then select Save this link as. Select the folder where you want to keep the file. Most modern mobile phones support custom ringtones that can embarrass you when it's your phone that has an incoming call. Google up ringtones and you'll get tons of sites that charge you a few dollars per show. Pshaw, I don't have you yet. With some free software and a few minutes, you get as many custom ringtones as your heart desires from an MP3 in your music collection without paying a dime. This is how. What you need:A mobile phone that plays MP3s and supports custom tones (most modern phones do these days)A way to transfer

the file to your phone (using a cord, Bluetooth or an email to your phone) Free sound editing software, AudacityEdit your MP3 to your phone, set it up as your ringtone and be done with it. But most full-length numbers are few corners AudacityEdit your MP3 to exactly 20 seconds you want and also add any effects. Download Audacity, install and fire it. Audacity can't edit mp3s out of the box, it needs the so-called LAME compression library first. Download the lame\_enc.dl file here and put it somewhere permanently on your hard drive. Choose Preferences from the Audacity Edit menu. On the File Formats tab, under MP3 Export Settings, click the Find Library button, and then browse to the dll you just downloaded, as shown (click to enlarge.) G/O Media can get a commission Now the fun begins. Make a copy of your MP3 file and store it in a temporary folder somewhere other than where your music player will find it. Drag and drop it on Audacity to open it. Using the Zoom and Playback buttons, you'll find the 20 seconds of your song that you want to ring. (It helps to zoom in so that time appears 5-second steps.) Use the selection tool to mark the 20-second ring, and on the Edit menu. (hoose Crop. Now you have your ringtone. Click here to enlarge the screenshot. If you're feeling bold and creative, browse Audacity's editing tools, especially in the effect menu. I'd like to the first of your phone, either by a wired or Bluetooth connection to your computer, or by emailing it to your phone's address. Once the file is on your phone, set it as your custom ring tone. How to do this will depend on your phone model; on Nokia phones with Symbian you do this in the Profiles area. On my Sprint LG, it's in the settings area, under Sounds, Ringers. Choose your tone wiselt's entirely up to you which song to use as your ringtone.
