The county chair is Kinston. The district was created in 1791 by European Americans from part of Dobbs County. They named the district after American Revolutionary War officer William Lenoir, who fought in the Battle of Mountain. The total area of the district is 403 square miles, most of which are land. According to the 2010 census, there were 59,495 people living in the area. The districts bordering Lenoir County are Greene County to the north, Pitt County in the north-east, Craven County in the east, Jones County in the south, Duplin County in the southwest, and Wayne County to the west. Declaration Recording Fee and all other documents: \$26.00 for the first 15 pages, \$4.00 for each additional page of Trust Deed; \$64.00 for up to 35 pages, and \$4.00 for each additional page Supplementary (multi-instrument): \$10.00 Non-standard documents: \$25.00 in addition to recording fees for documents that do not comply with recording standards. Effective 10/01/15, instruments containing excessive recording data cost \$2.00 for each party listed in instruments in excess of 20. In addition, excise tax must be included with a filing fee for action. Excise stamps are \$1 at every \$500 or breakdown of the consideration or value of the interest or property delivered, exclusive of the value of any lien or burden remaining at the property at the time of sale. Fees for Notaries Oaths: \$10.00 Certified Documents (excluding essentials): \$5.00 first page, \$2.00 per additional page of Document Formatting Requirements * Documents should be on a white paper 8.5 x 11-inch or 8.5 x 14-inch white paper. * Black ink should be used with font size no smaller than 9 dots. Empty in the instrument completed in the pen and correction can also be made in the pen. * The top of the first page must have a 3-inch margin. All the others on the first page and all margins on the next page should be at least 1/2 inches. * At the top of the first page, below the 3-inch margin, specify the title of the instrument (i.e. the deed of guarantee, stop deed claim, etc.) * Text should be on one side of the page only. * A person submitting a instrument for registration must report to the Deed Register of the amount of tax payable. It is the duty of the person presenting a instrument for registration to report the correct amount of tax payable. Before the instrument is recorded, the Register of Declarations must collect taxes due and indicate a instrument to indicate that the tax has been paid and the amount of tax paid.
