According to one source, the board had 72 members in 2001. [1] The Executive Board is chaired by a national chair, chosen by the national council. The members of the Board of Directors include regularly elected members, a regional official and a maximum of five designated youth members. The Scout Leader is secretary of the Board of Directors and a non-voting member. The national management board has several standing committees corresponding to the professional staff organisation of the national council. The establishment of a regulation authorizing the BSA of the Federal Charter[2] (36 USC 309) stipulates that the Board of Governors, made up of U.S. citizens, is the company's governing body. The number, validity and term of office of the members of the Board of Directors are laid down in the Statutes. The vacancy on the Board of Directors shall be filled by a majority of the remaining members of the Board of Directors. [2] The Board of Directors must also hold annual meetings and submit annual reports to the U.S. Congress. The membership rules provide that membership includes: [3] Up to 64 regular members elected annually at annual meetings of the National Council.
