Do you have a Georgia child support order but you don't get any benefits? If you have already received a child maintenance order and the parent who has not smoked with deprivation of liberty does not pay payments, or if the person you are ordered to pay is behind these payments, there are several tools at your disposal. Contact DCSS in Georgia. child support enforcement services are provided by the Georgia Department of Human Resources, The Child Support Services Division (DCSS). If you already have a case with DCSS, contact the assigned case manager. Be sure to have a copy of the original order when you try to execute an existing order. You can obtain the order at the Registry. The Child Maintenance Support Enforcement Unit has the power to collect late child maintenance (indebted) and to obtain medical protection through various administrative procedures without ever going to court. What can DCSS do to help with the support order? DCSS can do a few things for a parent who doesn't pay their child support, including: Withhold child support from a paycheck or unemployment benefit. Take over the federal and/or state income tax refund to pay child maintenance indebted. Garnish employee compensation benefits. Suspend or revoke a driver, professional or professional license for parents who are more than 60 days behind payment. File liens and taxes on tangible assets. Bring contempt for court actions that may be punished with a custodial sentence. Make compliance with child support orders a condition of parole. To submit a petition citing contempt Another option is filing a contempt claim against the court, which ordered payment. If it is established that the in-person parent not only executes the original order, but also, at the discretion of the judge, he may be subject to sanctions, such as deprivation of liberty or fines. If you don't care for the parents in jail, he is still responsible for keeping the child, even in prison. What can you do with a father(s) who has not smoked in prison if he is unable to make payments? If the father/mother involved in deprivation of liberty is having problems with payments, he should apply immediately to court. The parent can always seek to modify an existing support order. This will require a return to court and an explanation to the judge as to why you cannot make payments. Only a judge can change the amount you owe under the support order. In addition, a georgia court can order a father into the Paternity Program, the largest state paternity program in the country, which works with non-foster parents who owe child support but lack the ability to pay. If you have already obtained a child maintenance order and the parent who has not been cared for or who is ordered to pay, there are several tools that the court can use. A friend of the court and/or the Child Support Service may apply to the court for a parent to pay their child's maintenance allowance, including: deduction of parental income. Prosecution and contempt of court A friend of the Court can refer the case to the district attorney, who can bring charges against the person who owes support for a crime for which no support has been provided. The parents of the detainee may also ask the district attorney for felony unsuscended criminal After a certain amount of arrearages develop, the court can plan a contempt hearing. If the court decides that the payer could part or all of the amount due may be considered contempt by the payer. Penalties for contempt may include any of the methods of enforcement listed here (e.g. suspension of the driving licence), as well as fines, imprisonment times and other fines Modification of the order If a parent has trouble making payments, he or she should immediately go to court. The parent can always seek to modify an existing support order. This will require a return to court and an explanation to the judge as to why you cannot make payments. Only a judge can change the amount you owe under the support order. In addition, if any parent receives public assistance, a friend of the Court shall automatically review the amount of the child maintenance order every 36 months. Statutes of The New York Consolidated Laws FCT § 458-b Procedures for collecting current or overdue support income enforcement - A notice sent to a noncustodial parent's employer asking that the funds owed be deducted from their paycheck and sent to the SCU (this is not a salary garnish that requires a court order). Takeover of unemployment benefits - current and/or overdue child maintenance benefits are automatically deducted from unemployment benefits. The procedures for submitting a delay (delinquent) support to the credit bureau - the name of the criminal noncustodial parent company sent to consumer credit reporting agencies such as Experian - undermines their creditworthiness until late support is paid. Lottery Intercept - Any New York State lottery winnings can be withheld. Asset execution - Bank accounts and other financial assets can be seized. Driver's License Suspension Denial Passport - CSEU is working with the U.S. State Department to prevent crime noncustodial parents from obtaining or renewing a passport. Liens - Liens can be filed from real estate, personal injury awards, or other such property. Tax referrals - The name of a crime noncustodial parent is sent to the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance, which can collect overdue payments using tax remedies. Withdrawal of licences (business, professional, professional, recreational) - If the arrears (past amount) is equal to or greater than the value of the child's maintenance payments of 4 months (30-day notification to comply).
