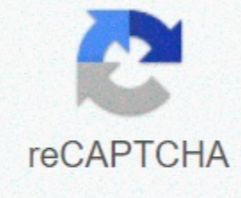

I was first elected to the city council in 2014 to fill an unseated term and re-elected in 2016. These last 6 years have been rewarding and challenging. It is my pleasure to serve the residents of Blytheewood for the last 6 years. I began my service career in 1977 as a petty officer in the United States Navy in Combat Squadron 101. After my honorable discharge, I continued my service as a firefighter who reached the rank of battalion chief in Columbia City. The traffic problems we face are addressing economic development that benefits both our businesses and residents. I would love to see what Blytheewood reviews to see if other water resources are available currently paying and researching. We are currently paying the Winnsboro Water Department outside county prices. With our next contract, we have to find a way to lower our water fees. Hospitality Tax and Accommodation Tax and Blytheewood support events are a Hospitality and Accommodation Tax to support our city and community events. I want to see these used to continue to deliver new events to meet the needs of our growing community. I want committees to review the support, and make the necessary changes.
