Thyagaraja was the largest among South Indian music composers and one of the musical prodigies of all time. He was the father of modern Karnataka music and his works are of subtle spirituality, full of melodic beauty and in the highest artistic sense. As a child he was as already remarkable for his talent for music and a gift for composing and writing his first song when he was barely 13. Soon he reached the highest peak of musical fame and composed the greatest songs ever written and two musical plays of the unsealed beauty. [1] On the popular Tyagaraja Aradhana lines are held by the Sanskriti Foundation[3], found in 2005 and registered in 2008 by ViloinVasu, a violinist, music teacher and researcher. The festival's history began in 2016 for fans of karnatic classical music in Hyderabad, otherwise traveling to Tyagaraja Aradana in Tamil Nadu. It was started by karnatic classical music artist, Violin Wasso. Among these events are Nagara Sankertana, followed by Pancharatna Brindandagnam. The music festival carries the same passion and spirit in the traditional Thiruvaiyaru style to Pancharatna Brindandagnam. The 2016 event was the opening ceremony of 3 day events, with 5 events. The 5th Hyderabad Tyagaraja Ardhana Music Festival (HTAMF) is a five-day karnatic music celebration from January 29 to February 2 in Shilparam, Madhapur. Everything is free and open to the public. It is being organized by the Sankiti Foundation in connection with Shilaparam, Hyderabad. The opening day night will feature a concert by N C Kousik Kalyan (vocal) along with Bhatti Pawan Singh (violin), P Srinivasa Gopalan (Mridangam) and R Srikanth (Kanjira). This will follow another vocal performance -- by Saroja and Sujata, aka the TK sisters, along with Behatti Pawan Singh (violin), S.A. Fanibushan (Mridangam) and R Srikanth (Kaniira), The concluding concert will showcase the day two singers B Indira Kameswara Rao and Neti Sarala, along with the same artists in the first concert. As organizers say, We strive to offer a wide variety of combinations of Tyagraja, as well as to ensure that informants listen to both rare and well-known poems. Also, with a few artists present each day, spectators can listen to a variety of bonnies or music schools.
