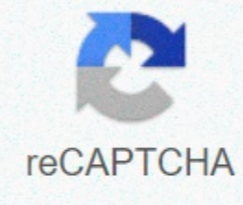

This emergency order revokes the exam requirement for all persons who have previously taken the NH Online boat safety course. The rule also applies to those who wish to complete an online course during the current state of emergency in New Hampshire. ALL EXAMS, TAKE EXAMS, ARE CANCELLED, AS THEY ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED. YOU WILL RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS BY EMAIL TO DOWNLOAD A 120-DAY TEMPORARY CERTIFICATE THAT WILL ALLOW YOU TO OPERATE YOUR BOAT LEGALLY UNTIL YOUR LIFE-LONG CARD ARRIVES IN THE MAIL. YOUR PERMANENT CARD WILL BE SENT TO AN ADDRESS YOU PROVIDED AT THE TIME THE COURSE WAS REGISTERED. ONCE YOU RECEIVE IT, YOUR PERMANENT CARD WILL NOT HAVE AN EXPIRATION DATE AND WILL NOT REQUIRE AN EXTENSION. AT THE SAME TIME, THE NH LAW REQUIRING ALL SHIP OPERATORS TO CARRY EVIDENCE OF BOAT TRAINING WHEN OPERATING BOATS OVER 25 HORSEPOWER REMAINS IN FULL.
