Jordan lake camping

FacebookTwitterPinterestMailThen sitting down on the shore of a deep blue lake, the fishing line hovering in the water as bald eagles soar overhead. Or imagine your camp standing next to a roaring campfire, smoke drifting through a cool autumn breeze as you gather with your friends and family. These are just some of the scenes that can determine your next Jordan Lake camping experience. Jordan Lake State Recreation Area (SRA) is a 14,000-acre reservoir 180 miles from the coastline, with seven swim beaches, and more than 14 miles of hiking trails. The SRA is less than an hour's drive from north Carolina's Chapel Hill, Durham and Raleigh research triangle. With more than 1,000 campsites around the lake, there's something for everyone to prefer an RV spot, tent bench, or primitive backcountry site. At Lake Jordan, water programs are the name of the game. Nine ships are launching their craft as well as several beach areas for swimming or launching their kayaks and SUPS. If you don't bring your own craft, the Crosswinds Boating Center hires kayaks and pontoon boats. Anglers are invited to cast, crappie, catfish, and pan fish. Or rather, watch the local wildlife fish. Jordan Lake is home to the largest community of bald eagles in the eastern U.S. Check them out on the lakeside or along the park's hiking trails. Whether you want to relax or play on the water, Lake Jordan should be your next outdoor destination. To help you choose your next Jordan Lake camping spot, we've gathered the best advice from campers on their favorite Jordan Lake campsites. 1. Summer point pic of the Dyrtr housing estate by Zach W. Offering a whopping 579 tents and RV campgrounds with seven separate loops, Poplar point is the largest campsite on Lake Jordan SRA. It's just 1 mile southeast of Wilsonville. More than half of the sites provide water and electric hookups, and each has a picnic table, grill, and lamp holder. Some sites are available in ADA. All loops have toilets, showers, garbage and recycling tanks; the dump stations are located near the entrance to the campsite. Some places are right on the lake, so don't forget to pack your kayak, water games and sunscreen. Other facilities include a children's playground, swimming pool, boat launch, amphitheater and hiking trail that connects all loops. Camping prices are \$19-\$62 per night. If you think you'll run out of things to do by not camping around a lake in big cities, think again. You may be out on water motor boats and jet skis, you can go kayaking, fishing, hiking and swimming in the designated places of most campsites. - Camping Dyrtr zach w. 2. Parkers Creek Picture of the Dyrtr caravan Angel G. Four campsite loops offering 250 RV and tent campsites, Parkers Creek offers solid Jordan camping - directly on the water. This site is located on a peninsula on the west side of the lake, about 4 km west of Wilsonville. At the top of the peninsula there is a group camp and some locations are available. Each campsite has a picnic table, a barbecue and lantern rack, and showers and restrooms nearby; a dump station is located near loop 1. This campsite offers a range of picnic shelters, hiking trails, including a short children's trail, with a swimming beach, amphitheater and boat rental. Camping prices are \$19-\$62 per night. This is the best campsite on Jordan Lake. There are beachside campsites, hiking trails and a swimming pool within walking distance of the campsite. When the tide is low... Just 0.5 miles north of Wilsonville, Crosswinds Camping offers 182 tents and RV campgrounds in three loops. Most are water and electric hookups, and each spot is equipped with a picnic table, grill, and lamp holder. Each loop features restrooms, showers, and at least one ADA accessible spot; There is also a pouring station nearby. A short hiking trail connects all three loops with the launch of the ship and the amphitheater near Loop A. According to the campsite report, this campsite is amply shaded and has great beach access. The smallest of the advanced campsites on Lake Jordan, Vista Point is perfect for those looking for some peace and quiet during their Jordan Lake getaway. This campsite is located on the west side of Lake Jordan, about 7 miles southwest of Wilsonville. These sites offer 50 campsites, all with water and electric hookups, and five groups of tent campsites. On-site facilities include restrooms, showers, garbage cans and a dump site. Although this site is open all year round, water pumps are turned off in winter. There is also a picnic area, volleyball court, two hiking trails, a swimming pool and two boats. Camping prices are \$24-\$62/night. 5. New Hope Overlook Image from The Dyrtr camper Angel G. For those looking to sleep off the beaten path, the New Hope Overlook campground has 24 primitive sites in two areas on the southeastern shores of Jordan Lake. This campsite is located about 6 miles southwest of Wilsonville, near the B. Everett Jordan Dam. These walk-in sites are located up to an 8000 metres from the car parks, so you should be ready to pack your gear. Their primitive environment these sites are places picnic tables, grills and lantern racks. All camp areas have vault toilets and drinking water. There are many hiking trails in the area, as well as a boat shot. Camping prices are \$12/night. Please note that all poplar point loop e locations are walk-ups and can only be booked when you arrive at the campsite. ► Backpack camping For those who prefer a primitive campsite, New Hope Overlook offers 24 camping nests in the woods. These sites are 100 metres from the car park. Each spot has a picnic table, grill, and lamp holder. Nearby toilets and drinking water are also available. ► Group tent camping in two areas offer sections of camping clubs and other groups. Parkers Creek has six campsites available group tent camping. Vista Point also offers five groups of tent campsites. Drinking showers can be found nearby. ► Group RV Camping Vista Point offers 50 campsites group RV camping.
