This is when an author or speaker gives an object or idea human characteristics, abilities or qualities. Here is an example of the personification: Slana paints the pines in winter. In this example, the author gives cold the ability to paint. Frost can't paint. Frost sthis human ability, the writer gives it oph. That's more poetic than saying pine trees are frosty. Sometimes students have difficulty determining personification and distinguishing it from other figurative techniques. I think this is because they need more practice by working with examples of personification. These worksheets will give students they need.
