Your student can check out the transportation plan for Thanksgiving Day meals and other eateries over break. Winter holidays (December) For the winter holidays, dining rooms and outlets have a varying schedule: Dining rooms serve breakfast, lunch and dinner as follows: Bursley: until December 21, closed December 22 until classes resume. East Quad: until December 19, closed December 20 until classes resume. Markley: until December 15, closed December 16 to Resume. Mosher-Jordan: until December 21, closed December 22 until classes resume. North Quad: until December 19, closed December 20 until classes resume. South Quad: until December 21, closed December 22 until classes resume. Twigs: until December 19, closed December 20 until classes resume. Retail: Check each location's website for specific availability. Around town during breaks: If campus dining options are not available, students can explore Ann Arbor's restaurants. Near campus there are two main areas where students can enjoy delicious food. South University Avenue offers a wide variety of food including burritos, sushi, bi bim bop, subs, pizza and more. State Street has many fast and easy foods, all under \$10, including mediterranean, Mexican, Italian and more. In addition, Ann Arbor is a great place for quiet, sit-down dining. The restaurants are plentiful on Main Street, Liberty Street and Kerrytown. It's probably something that suits the student's taste and budget. In addition to finding delicious meal options, students can stay busy by exploring Ann Arbor. They can visit the Ann Arbor Convention and Visitors Bureau website for a list of events.
