And that shouldn't change when the company reports earnings on Tuesday. Analysts predict Home Depot will report a profit of \$1.33 per share in the fiscal fourth quarter, which ended on January 31, according to FactSet - an expected 14% increase from the numbers a year ago. Sales are expected to grow 4 percent to \$21.8 billion. And the results might even beat those estimates. Why the confidence? There's Home Depot's track record: Earnings have overtaken Wall Street forecasts for eight quarters in a row, and there are no signs that the winning streak is ending. Home Depot also reports at the end of earnings season, which means investors already have plenty of information from companies selling their products at its stores, including paint maker Sherwin Williams (SHW), appliance maker Wyrldpool (WHR), tool company Stanley Black & Decker (SWK) and cabinet manufacturer Masco (MAS). RBC's Scotsman Ciccarelli argues that their results and guidance were strong enough to suggest that Home Depot's earnings should be just fine. Vendor channel commentary We track points to healthy growth in the fourth quarter, wrote in a letter to customers last week. Home Depot should also get a boost from an economy that seems increasingly supportive. In a report released last month, Shimon Gutman of Morgan Stanley noted that household formation has risen because house prices are expected to rise by 4% in 2017. We see a positive risk-reward bias for both Home Depot and Lowe's, he wrote. Even a pay rise, which could be a problem for many retailers, may be a plus for Home Depot. Analyzing Bureau of Labor Statistics data on spending levels, Wolf Research analyst Scott Mushkin found that consumers spend 15 cents of every extra dollar on housing, the largest recipient of any category. We see this as very good news for hardliners associated with our housing like Home Depot, Lowe's and Sherwin-Williams, explains Mushkin. The biggest concern about Home Depot may be its valuation. Its shares are trading at 20.5 times 12-month profit forecasts, above the five-year average of 19.5, and for sales of 1.8 times, above the five-year average of 1.5. But valuations outweigh other factors, says Stuart Kaye, portfolio manager at Materine Wealth Management. He points to Home Depot's skill at capital allocation – buybacks, for example, were generally profitable – and the company's rapid and stable growth. Home Depot doesn't look cheap, says Kay. But it's not a surprise, considering the business looks really good. Home Depot's stock appears to be behind after hitting \$134.74 on November 27, 2015, the shares remained in range, briefly. Up to slightly higher highs in May and August before the fall. Last week, Home Depot escaped that range to an all-time high of \$143.
