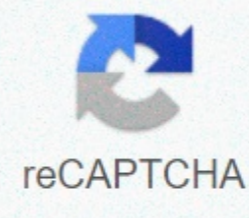

Are you planning to take a SAT? Well, some universities require you to apply for a SAT in an essay. Some people don't care if they submit a SOT score with or without an essay. This article provides a complete list of universities that need or recommend a SAT in an essay. What is an optional SAT essay? In the case of essays, you have 50 minutes to read a passage (similar to the one found in the reading section) and write an essay that dissects how the author discussed it. Did the author use evidence to support the main claims? But if you take a SAT in an essay, an optional essay will add 50 minutes. It also costs more to take a SAT in an essay: .64.50 vs. .49.50 without essays. Don't assume that you have to take an essay automatically. Whether it's important or not depends on which school (and scholarship) you're applying to and what other applications look like. Currently, Ivy League School does not require students to take a SAT in an essay. The same is true of Stanford, Caltech, Duke, Georgetown, Johns Hopkins, MIT, Northwestern, NUI, and UChicago. Many of these schools no longer recommend students to take THE in essays that are a major shift from just a few years ago. Similarly, most liberal arts colleges do not require or recommend a SAT. However, there are a few exceptions, such as Soka University. In general, most state schools don't even need a SAT with essays, but there's still a good part of it. There is a tendency for strange differences to occur in the state. For example, every school in the University of California needs a SAT and an essay, but most of the schools at California State University don't. Regardless of the type of school you are applying for, don't assume you're asking for a SOT in every essay. Check with all schools to understand the test requirements. Whether you take it or not, that's the problem. How to decide whether to take a SAT essay: When making a decision about whether to take a SAT with a 4-question essay or a SAT without an essay, you need to consider the following four questions:Is there a school I would like to apply for in order to need a SAT essay? If you take THE without essays, your application will be incomplete and you will not be able to admit. In contrast, if you apply for a school

that does not require a SAT essay, these schools accept both types of SAT scores, so you can receive SAT in essays (with or without essays). Again, universities that require SAT essays don't consider your score if they take SAT without essays. The last thing you want to do is to get a good score by taking a SAT without an essay, but you will know that one of your target schools needs to take a SAT in an essay. For some universities, the application policy changes year by year, so please double-check the test policy of the school you are applying for. #2: Is there a school I would like to apply for to recommend a SAT essay? If you haven't applied to a school that requires a SAT essay section, but you're applying to a school that recommends it, we recommend that you continue to take it. This provides another dimension that the school can use to evaluate the application. However, you may not want to take a SAT in an essay. If, for some reason, you are not eligible for SAT fee exemption, paying extra expenses to take SAT in an essay will be a financial burden on you, and don't feel as if you have to take it. In this case, it's good to take a SAT without an essay instead. In addition, if you are really struggling to write an essay under time constraints (due to anxiety), you can opt out of the essay. However, I usually recommend this only to students who have strong English and writing skills but are struggling to write a consistent essay if there is additional pressure on time constraints. For example, you get As in an essay that you can work on at home, but it's easy to get nervous, so Cs in an essay in class? #3: Do you apply for scholarships that require SAT with essay scores? Therefore, please check the requirements for each scholarship you apply for. Scholarships that do not require SAT essays should still accept your SAT with essay scores, but scholarships that require an essay section will not consider your SAT score if you took a no essay version. #4: Does SAT essay enhance my application in other ways? In fact, universities that don't recommend or need essays don't really pay much attention to it. Nevertheless, essays may be useful internationally want to prove that they have strong English skills and I think they do it particularly well. If you are in this category and you are sure you will get a high score on it (e.g., after doing a practice essay), definitely consider taking a SAT in an essay.
