The Kansas Golf Association was organized in 1908 and is a nonprofit organization that governs amateur golf in Kansas state. In addition to conducting 17 championships for amateur golfers in the state, the KGA is responsible for managing the programs of the Kansas Youth Golf Association and Kga senior series. KGA also maintains the USGA Disability System, conducts course rankings throughout Kansas and supports other related programs and scholarships. The partnership will provide additional opportunities to host KGA tournaments statewide at Eagle Bend and will also provide program support in developing youth golf courses at Eagle Bend. The youth golf program is currently underdeveloped in Lawrence; by Eagle Bend in partnership with the Kansas Golf Association there will be local cooperative efforts to access programs and grants provided by the American Golf Association to develop the game of golf in the community. The following preliminary discussion points for an agreement between the city and the KGA were discussed at the November 5, 2016 board meeting for KGA. This concept has been supported by their board; these items will be the starting point for a more formal agreement that will need to be drawn up by the City Attorney's office. 1. KGA will be obliged to lease long-term office space within the limits of the Eagle Bend Golf Course club starting in the fall of 2017, with the option of reproducing later at the rental level. (Note: The city expects to negotiate a minimum of an initial five-year lease) 2. The KGA will pay monthly fees in the amount of \$2,500 for about 1200 square feet of dedicated office space. The KGA space will be designed to include 3 executive offices, a large workstation that can accommodate 3 workstations, a storage room, an ensuite, a break room with sink and refrigerator, access and private security, access back door to load event equipment for vehicles, and separate storage of large tournament equipment (likely in the cart storage area). The Kansas Golf Foundation will also be providing space dedicated to creating, displaying and maintaining the Kansas Golf Hall of Fame and the KGA will be responsible for caring for and updating the displays in the Hall of Fame. KGF and KGA will not charge for this space. 4. Both Kga and KGF will have the opportunity to actively participate in the architectural design process of the space dedicated to its office and the Hall of Fame. 5. KGA is committed to conducting minimum number of golf competitions at Eagle Bend Golf Course every year. At this time, those events will be the Kansas Four-Ball (also a qualifying event for the Heart of America Four-Ball) (2 days on weekends in June), a Kansas Junior Section (1 day), a KGA Senior Series event (1 day), a final chance qualifier for the Kansas Amateur (1 day in July). Other events may include USGA qualifiers, events sanctioned by Heartland Golf (an alliance between the KGA, the Kansas City Golf Association and the Kansas Women's Golf Association) and Kga's other day-long championships. Eagle Bend currently hosts the Kansas Four- Ball (2 days), Kansas Junior Section (1 day) and Final Chance Qualifier (1 day). This was Eagle Bend's first year in the Final Opportunity Qualifier and this is the second year the Four Ball Championship has been held. Kansas Bend usually hosts an annual Junior Section event. 6. KGA will also agree to engage with eagle bend golf course staff to plan and manage programs to develop games and bring more patrons to city golf facilities (juniors, women, seniors). The city intends to negotiate a minimum 5-year lease term 2020 Schedule: To apply to compete in a Senior Series event, you must first register and pay for annual members of the Senior Series program. In addition to the chance to win a gift certificate, male candidates can qualify for the 2020 Senior Golf Championships at Firekeeper Golf Course (Mayetta, 21-22 September 2020. Top Fourteen Male Finisher in Senior Series Series (six totals, six nets and two overall captains selected) will be selected on the Kansas senior team for the Ozark Senior Challenge, a team event with the Missouri Golf Association that will be held at Twin Hills Golf & Country Club (Joplin, MO) on October 13-15, 2020. A super senior team will play a similar team from the Missouri Golf Association which will be held at Twin Hills Golf & Country Club (Joplin, MO) on October 13-15, 2020. This ten-member team's team (four total, four nets and two overall captain selections) will also be selected in the Senior Series Championship from men's players aged 65 and over. Each Senior Series entry will include your green charge, golf cart, ball range and a chance to win gift certificates (either total or net). Points earned to qualify for the Senior Series Championship will be awarded by the age department. Eligible to be open to senior golfers who have reached their 50th birthday on or before the date of any Senior Series event. Your age on the day of any event will determine the age divide to earn Senior Series Championship points. Therefore, it is possible that a player can compete in two different age divisions throughout the schedule. We must have a functioning USGA GHIN. There is no requirement for maximum age or Acceptance Index. Membership fees & membership entrance fees in the premium series are \$65 per year. Membership fees must be paid before participating online for tournaments. Click here to pay your membership fee. The Senior Series event entry fee is \$77 for each mass event entered. This entrance fee includes green fees, golf carts, ball range and the chance to win gift certificates. Practice rounds are not included as part of the entry fee. Competition terms for senior league championship points will be conducted in five men's age divisions: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 &amp; older. The women's department is separate. All age parts play will play 18 holes. Competition is both total and net scored. The entire sector will compete for both total and net gift certificates in two men's age divisions (50-54, 65 & older) and one for women. The amount of which will be based on the number of players in each age division. Players can only win one (1) gift voucher (total or net) per event. Scores from each Senior Series event will be posted to the GHIN acceptance system. For most events, two sets of tees will be used for each Senior Series event for men. The 50-year-old will play a longer set of tees followed by 65 & older age divisions. The women's department plays a forward set of tees. In the case of ties, the same number of points is awarded to each player attached to that position. However, since the player can only receive one gift voucher (total or net, which, which is greater), it is possible that the player can receive string points but not win gift vouchers and vice versa. Based on the points earned at mass events, the 15 members with the highest total revenue and the top 15 net members from each age division of the five men will qualify for the Senior Series Championship. * Eligible male members must play for at least four (4) regular season Senior Series events to qualify for the season-ending Senior Series Championship. The event request year includes any events that have been cancelled and/or rescheduled due to the weather. In the Senior Series Championship, all contestants will play 36 holes, scoring both overall and net points in their respective age divisions. Gift certificate awards, both total and net, will be awarded (only one gift certificate is awarded to any one player, total or net, which, according to the greatest conditions). Senior Cup Team Qualifying The top six (6) gross, top six (6) net contestants and two (2) gross captain's pick from the field of the Senior Series Championship will be named to the Kansas Senior Team for the Ozark Senior Challenge. Only male members of the Senior Series Championship will be named to the Kansas Senior Team. Top four (4) total, top four (4) net contestants and two (2) total captain selections of those at least 65 years old from the field of the Senior Series Championship will be named for the Kansas Association Senior Cup Team. Only men participating in the Senior League Championship will be named to the Kansas Association Senior Cup Team. NOTE: A player must tell which team he intends to try to qualifying for before the start of the competition. Note: All final bronze members in their age group, total or net, will be eligible to participate in the Senior Series Series Championship. No tie-breaking procedure will be applied. The number of qualifiers for Senior Series Series Championship from each age division will be as follows: Age 50-54 top 15 members, total and net Age 55-59 top 15 members, total and net Age 60-64 top 15 members, total and net Age 65-69 top 15 members, total and net Age 70 + top 15 members, total
