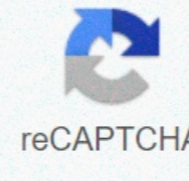

Credit or The service tax on the charge card, which was abolished when the Goods and Services Tax was implemented back in 2015, has been made back in the new model proposed for sales and services tax (sst), which is due to apply on September 1, 2.0 According to the Royal Malaysia Customs website, under frequently asked questions on service tax, the following question was described as 35: Q: Will I be charged on the existing credit or charge card on RM25 on September 1, 2018? A: The current effective period of cards will not be subject to service tax of RM25 until the next annual renewal. In other words, The tax on EACH credit or charge card of RM25 which will be charged for card renewal. It should be remembered that the amount is less than the old service tax model. Under the old service tax model, a one year RM50 tax service was applicable on each principal credit card and charge card, and service tax of RM25 was applicable to each supplementary card. The RM25 charge under SST 2.0 will be applicable to each credit or charge card, even if it is a principal or supplementary card. The service tax was applicable on September 1, 2018, taking place of goods and services tax which no longer has any effect applicable with September 1, 2018.
