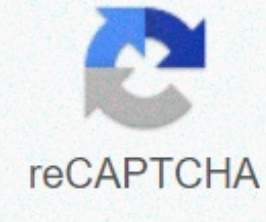




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## Buy google accounts

By Avery Martin Gmail gives you the ability to add a second-mail account to your Google account to review email messages from more than one address or to give others access to your email account and send and receive emails on your behalf. Once you've added a new account, you can always remove permissions later by accessing the Accounts tab in the Gmail Settings section. A third option involves allowing multiple account logins so you can quickly switch between Google accounts. Click the current gear icon login to your Gmail account and select the Settings option. Click the Accounts tab and select Add Other E-mail Addresses You Own in the Send Mail Section as. Add your second email address in the E-mail Address field. Make sure you've already registered the email address you want to use. Click the Next Step button and select the Send Authentication button. Check your email inbox for newly added accounts and click the confirmation link to verify and activate the new email address. Return to the Accounts tab in your Gmail account and select the Add Other Account link in the Give Access section to Your Account. Add the email address you want to allow to access your account in the E-mail Address field. Click Send E-mail to Grant Access. Sign in to a new email address account, or wait for the recipient to verify access by automatically clicking the confirmation link in the resulting email. Sign in to one of your Google products. Click your name or email address in the Google menu bar. Click Add Account from the drop-down menu. Enter the email address and password for another Google account and select Sign In. You can now switch between accounts by clicking your name or email address in the menu bar and selecting the account you want to use. Google Tutor has devised a fairly intelligent way to back up your Gmail account using Google Groups. Basically, you'll create a private group and configure it to act as a remote archive. From there you only provide filters and forwarding in your Gmail account so that a copy of your messages is sent to a new group.
