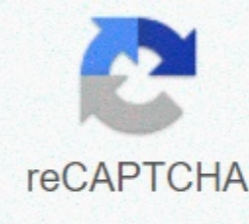

Alpha Spinner The Alpha Spinner is one of the top quality spinners in that style that has not been seen before by other spinners. It was skillfully developed using cnc-dressed technique from 954 bearing bronze. The buttons are stainless steel and hold the entire Silicon Nitride ceramic bearing. The pocket top is interchangeable with the base button. This spinner sells for \$200.00.4. TI EDC Hand Finger Spinner Hold this spinner in hand and press the central button to make it rotate. Small and detached, this spinner is only 60mm tall, 60mm wide and 11mm deep. The spinner weighs 130g and has an iridescent look in the metal. Do not use oil or grease on the bearing of this spinner ball, as it will cause resistance and will not rotate properly. Only for alcohol it is recommended to clean the ball bearing to remove dirt and dust. This spinner sells for \$254.10.5. Crusader - Bronze The Crusader spinner, bronze, length 66mm and weight 58-60 grams. It is made of 37-38 grams of titanium, but all the materials used for this spinner are bronze and titanium. It was designed with hybrid ceramic 688 bearings that are removable. The length of the spinner is 66mm and is usually a hand-twisted spinner, but has the possibility of a spin table. buttons are screwed and each side has 12 rivets (48 in total). The rotation time for crusaders is: Bronze is about 4 minutes and titanium is about 3 minutes. This spinner sells for \$260.00.6. Turbine Spinner The Turbine Fidget Spinner is made of class 2 pure titanium. The main structure of the body is 12mm thick and is 18mm thick to the buttons. Black Lotus Tri Spinner The Black Lotus Tri Spinner is made of sintered stainless steel, which is infused with bronze. The body is a whole one piece with 2 buttons to activate the spinning. It can rotate and has a rotation radius of 25 mm (1 inch). Black Lotus sells for \$300.00.8. Weiheng Individual Hand Spinner 925 Silver Fidget This Weiheng Individual Hand Spinner is made of stabilized wood along with SKF hybrid ceramic bearing. The rotation time will depend on your skills, but it can rotate from 1 to 4 minutes. To get this spinner to rotate, hold the spinner in one hand and hit it with the other. This spinner sells for \$339.99.9. Silver Fidget Spinner by Sunnytech This fidget spinner sells for about \$459.00 and is 65mm long, 34mm wide and 9mm thick. It weighs 110 grams and is made of Silicon nitride bearings, 925 sterling silver, rivets. The rotation time for this fidget spinner is about 6 minutes. The weight of silver is 99.1 g. It is recommended to regularly clean the bearing with alcohol so that the dust is away, which can affect its rotation. Hold the spinner with one hand and quickly turn it with the other so that he will not comply, giving him regular strikes.10.
