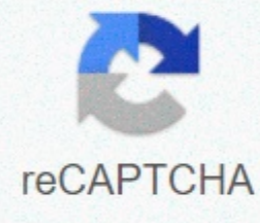

## Harry potter and the sorcerer's stone watch online reddit

You want to see the Harry Potter movies in order? In this piece, we'll explain exactly how you do it. Before comic book superheroes and Star Wars invaded the box office, Harry Potter was the biggest movie series. Replicating JK Rowling's surprisingly successful novels, the story of a wizard child avenging his parents' death by confronting his killer, Lord Voldemort, face-to-face has dominated the reading lists of entire generations. Rowling has also returned to the past of his wizard world, scripting the prequel films of the Fantastic Beasts of the 1920s that introduce an early version of Albus Dumbledore, and his former friend/arch-enemy Gellert Grindelwald. Production of a third Fantastic Beasts film is destined to begin this year. That means there are 10 films in the World of Harry Potter in which it gets stuck, spanning seven decades of magical history. But how does they all fit in? And what's the best order to watch the Harry Potter movies? You will find in this guide all the fantastic Harry Potter movies and how to watch them (if you are in the USA, they are free to broadcast on the Peacock service until the end of October 2020). Harry Potter films in chronological order (Image Credit: Warner Bros)Before you enjoy the Harry Potter movies in chronological order, it's worth knowing that there are three more Fantastic Beasts prequel movies planned. We know that the series will end with a duel between Albus Dumbledore and the former BFF turned nemesis Gellert Grindelwald in 1945, but everything in between is currently a mystery. Note that outside the United States, Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone is known as Harry Potter and the Stone Aside from the occasional flashback, the show's Hogwarts films follow a simple linear structure, mainly thanks to Rowling's decision to use the British school calendar as a framework for his narrative. that each of the seven books in the Potter series focuses on a different school year (running from September to August), starting in 1991, when Harry was 11. (Although the films were made in the 1990s, and feature occasional anachronism such as 21st century mobile phones or music, they are likely to follow the same carefully crafted timeline as Rowling's books - placing Harry Potter films about 70 years after their Fantastic Beast counterparts.) And the story of Harry Potter continues in the future, though not on screen, thanks to the hit play Harry Potter and the Cursed Child. The story picks up in 2017, during the epilogue to Harry Potter and The Deathly Hallows, and features the now-adult Harry, Hermione and Ron, and their children. That means there is no need to introduce any Machete Order however, although if we get any mass revelation in Beasts 3, 4 and 5, that may change. Fantastic Beasts 3 began shooting in early 2020, before a 2021 release. It's also interesting to note that there are more Harry Potter movies than books, with the seventh installment The Deathly Relics divided into two parts (a trick repeated by Twilight and The Hunger Games) because there was a lot of story to fit in. The two Fantastic Beasts films are notably the least beloved entries in the world of wizards, a fact perhaps reflected by the fall of the second film at the box office. The most successful of the two, Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them, made more money than just one of the Potter (Prisoner of Azkaban) films, but seeing that he had 12 years of inflation on his side, it's debatable whether he actually outperformed the previous film.
