Tomatoes like fertile, well-drained soils rich in organic matter. Dig in finished compost and manure, and add 1 cup of complete organic fertilizer under each transplant. The diet of heavy clay soils is excellent for tomatoes, but they are slowly too warm, so the transplant should be performed later. At the same time, lighter soils warm faster, so that transplants can go out earlier. Adding glacial rock dust will provide all the calcium they need. Regular irrigation is important, but do not let the plants sit in the water. Tomatoes are tropical plants, so they need full sun and a lot of heat. Grape varieties need a kind of support such as a wire to grow up, or a grid to which one can be bound when the plant grows. Bush species benefit from the support of a tomato cage to prevent their spread. At the time of the final transplant, plants can be buried up to their first pair of real leaves. This will promote greater root growth and help with both nutrient absorption and plant ability to withstand dry conditions. Stop watering towards the end of July to promote the fruit to ripen. If your plants are under lock and key, you can promote pollination and fruit set by tapping the trunk from time to time. Tomatoes do not rely on insects for pollination. Vibratingly, the plant shakes pollen loosely in the flowers, which then dust themselves. Indeterminate tomatoes continue to grow and produce fruit until they are killed by frost. Remove any suckers (stems that grow from the crotch of the leaves) to keep the foliage under control, and they will set a later harvest of larger fruits. Certain varieties usually produce fruit in a concentrated period of time. Your suction cups are not normally removed, although some trims help with ventilation. Ventilation.

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
