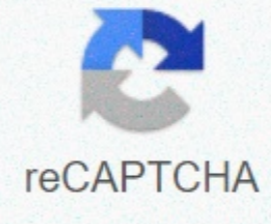

But you don't want to give a two- or three-word answer for fear that you ignored the interviewer and. And. It's up to you to decide you want to answer the question. The word you use might depend on the type of job you're interviewing for, what others are saying about you, or where you're following in the footsteps of your career. Use a word that matches the most important skill for the job. For example, if you request a hotel housekeeping job, consider using a word such as conscientious, thoughtful or effective. These are features that would serve you well in a position where the company's hope is that employees follow strict procedures for work tasks, such as cleaning, hotel accommodation and time management that they spend on several projects every day. Think about the words colleagues use to describe you. Using a word based on someone else's perception can carry more weight than trying to evoke a word that could make it come out as a boastful or imassuming. When the interviewer asks for that word, you could say, my colleagues usually tell me that I'm on the most trusted member of our team, because I can count on to pull my weight and then some when we have a team mission. In this case, it is necessary to detail on the reason for choosing this word. Use a word that will help you get that promotion if you're interviewing for a job with your current employer.
