## J2 ead application requirements

J-2 visa holders are eligible to apply for work with USCIS as long as J-1 remains valid J-1 status. Employment for J-2 dependents cannot be used to provide basic requirements or educational expenses for J-1 visa holders. Employment approvals are available for any type of employment and even multiple jobs at the same time. The application is not based on employment offers and does not. Limited The application may take 90-120 days to process by USCIS. J-2 employment approval applications include: A cover letter to USCIS that states that J-2 earnings will not be used to support J-1, for example: I am applying for employment approval as a J-2 dependent, my husband (or wife) is on a J-1 visa status as a student (or academic) and has sufficient funds for his (or her) support. Any income from my employment will not be used to support J-1 or myself. I will use this income for the purpose of enhancing culture and recreation. You may elaborate on the types of cultural or recreational activities you want to pursue. We recommend that you submit a budget source and funding source to ensure that the revenue you may receive will not support you or j-1 visa holders. If the question doesn't apply to you, type or type N/A or for replying to the NONE number, unless otherwise instructed. Question 8: You may not have an alien number. If you do not request, you will now have to do a separate application with the Social Security Office. Copies of previously issued employment authorization (EAD) passport photos of the same color, two full front view photos, measured 2 by 2, the head of the image should be measured between 1 and 1 3/8. Type the name and I-94 number on the back of both photos. Place the picture in an envelope. Write your name and your I-94 number clearly on the envelope. You can find the information at the bottom of the USCIS direct address for form I-765 filing for employment approval. You should receive your Employment Authorization (EAD) card in the letter within 75-90 days. 2 Is not eligible to be hired until uscis employment approval in the form of employment authorization (EAD) date of employment authorization for J-2 visa holders is specified in EAD and usually matches the date on form DS-2019, when an application received from USCIS can take up to four months to approve. We recommend that you make a copy of your entire employment approval application for your own records before sending them by mail to USCIS. While this is an option, there are many problems with the process. If you have any questions, please contact HIO at 617-495-2789, Social Security J-2 number and taxes when you get j-2 job approval, you must apply your Social Security number (SSN) to remove your Passport Form I-94, both Form DS-2019 and J-1's Form DS-2019, and EAD to the following Social Security Administration office between 9.m:00. Until 4.m pm, 10 Fawcett Street, 1st Floor, Cambridge MA 02138 from Harvard Square T Station, take 78 or 74 buses to Fawcett Street, 10 Causeway Street, Room 148, 1st Floor, Boston MA 02222, use the green or orange line to the North Station. The office is in the Thomas P. O'Neill Building at the Social Security Office. After you fill in and deliver on the SSN application form, you will receive your SSN notification in the letter. Income earned by J-2 dependents is subject to federal and state income taxes, including Social Security and Medicare taxes. J-2 work permits are derived from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) through The process takes an average of 3-5 months to process. Employment may not begin until J-2 obtains a work permit called the Employment Authorization Document (EAD) EAD allows J-2 to depend on any full-time or part-time job. Ead extensions are possible until the end date in DS-2019. There is an increased risk of traveling outside the United States while your EAD application is pending. The application process, please refer to the application guide for J-2 dependents for information on the application process. Work permits are permitted by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) if employment to support J-2 spouses and/or young children in the U.S., but not for the support of J-1 exchange visitors, if income is needed to support visitors to the J-1 exchange, USCIS will not authorize employment. You should also keep your parcel return receipt as proof that you submitted the application in a timely manner. The U.S. Postal Service cannot forward USCIS government mail using the USPS mail forwarding service. Your right to work will not take effect until USCIS approves, which can take several months. Once approved, USCIS will send you an employment authorization card (EAD). Keep a paper slip on your EAD card because you'll need to use it for any EAD extension application, Social Security number and tax after receiving your EAD card. The income of J-2 visa holders is subject to U.S. Social Security taxes, including federal and state income taxes. View the IRS 519 publication, the U.S. Tax Guide for Aliens, available from the IRS (website: ). Extending J-2 employment approvals is generally allowed one year at a time, but can be allowed for a maximum of 4 years. Prior to the J-2's application to USCIS, it is important to extend the stay and extend the employment authorization process before the expiration date in J-1's current DS-2019 form. The application process for extending/renewing employment approvals is the same as your original authorization. Send a copy of your current EAD card, including the paper slip that your current EAD is attached to when you receive it in the mail, along with other necessary documents specified in the checklist. J-2 dependents may apply for an extension. Renew employment authorization up to 180 days before the expiration date of the original EAD card.
