The green check mark indicates that the file is on your computer and synced with OneDrive as well. This typically indicates that the file has been opened. If you have a green check mark, you will have access to the file when you are not connected to the Internet. The solid green check mark is similar to the green check mark. This file is located on your local computer and syncs with OneDrive. This will prevent the document from being removed from your local computer by OneDrive. It's still syncing OneDrive, but will always keep a copy on the computer itself. This is good for files that you know you will need offline on a regular basis. You can add this property by right-clicking the file and selecting Always Keep on This Device. The red X icon indicates that a file is not synced with OneDrive. These can be several reasons, such as an invalid file name or an unsupported file type. Keep in mind that just because a folder (like the example) has a red X doesn't mean the entire folder isn't synced. A single unsynchronized document in a folder can create a red X icon.
