MP3 Juice is a music downloader that lets you search for music, listen in the app, and download songs for free so you can listen to songs offline. You can access millions of your favorite songs by title search or artists and albums. This free Android app will search sources like YouTube and SoundCloud to find the music you're looking for. Downloading MP3 Juice requires Android 4.0.3 and up. Users will need to download and install the APK file on their Android device, not search in the Google Play Store. Mp3 Juice's premise pairs with a very simple and somewhat amateur interface consisting of a search box and a source manager. Users type a search query, select the sources they want to search to, and then click the search button. Alternatively, you can also pour into the VIDEO URL and click the search button to convert the video sound to an MP3 file. Music can be played through YouTube, SoundCloud, VK, Yandex, 4shared, PromoDJ and Archive, giving access to millions of songs and artists. Once the search results have been restored, users can listen to the song directly in the app, most often by streaming the video directly from the original website. Alternatively, you can choose to download a song directly to your phone, save it to cloud storage (or Dropbox or Google Drive), or share it via Facebook. The app also contains an MP3 slicer that users can use to remove sound-free sections from MP3 files. We tried this feature and found that the resulting cut MP3 file simply became inaudible after we downloaded it. Annoying pop-ups and download fails Using MP3 Juice has sometimes been a frustrating experience. Many times we have found that downloads have failed. When this happens, the app doesn't tell you that the download failed. Instead, the app takes you to random news or ads — many of which push a user's subscription. Some users may mistake this as part of the MP3 download process and unknowingly sign up for something they don't want. We thought it was a bit unfair and didn't like how hard it was to leave these sites and go back to the search engine site. The app also contains other functions such as internet radio and music (available under the pal on the left side of the screen), but we found that they just didn't work. Links to entertainment news and Amazon — also available under men — felt disconnected from the app's goal. The app didn't feel safe for us, with its intrusive pop-up ads and attempts to get us to download other apps. It certainly didn't feel safe to connect our cloud storage and Facebook profiles so we didn't test that functionality. Is MP3 Juice legal? Of course, the largest With MP3 Juice, the question is whether downloading music using the app is legal or not. Unfortunately, it's legal. Legally, different laws applicable in different jurisdictions and situations. Converting music from YouTube or other similar video platforms, for example, is against US copyright law. In addition, YouTube considers downloading audio from its host video a violation of its Terms of Service, while SoundCloud offers its users tips on how to avoid unauthorized downloads and stream-rips of their content. On the other hand, much of the content available through archives is covered by Creative Commons licenses. However, many of these licenses do not explicitly allow you to download mp3 files for personal use. Ultimately, it is up to the user to decide whether they feel comfortable using an app that has questionable legal — and moral — standing. We recommend that you first consider trying legitimate alternatives to MP3 Juice. You can play Music from YouTube without violating the streaming site's terms of use through YouTube Music. MP3 Juice makes a wide range of songs as easy to search, play and download as MP3 files. The built-in player is simple, but it works pretty well - although downloading songs isn't without problems. The app's very basic and amateur interface, coupled with annoying pop-up ads, doesn't inspire confidence in its security. Do you need to download it? Using MP3 Juice to convert video to sound to download it as an MP3 file presents vague legal and moral issues related to copyright and intellectual property. Visit one of the many websites selling MP3 files--Amazon.com, Walmart.com, iTunes.com, Napster.com and MP3Download.net are several large ones. Most of them require you to register a user account. Most sites charge a fee to download MP3 files. Typically, a membership allows you to download a certain number of MP3 files each month. Files can be purchased with a credit card or gift card. MP3 files are usually intended for personal, non-commercial use. You can burn files to a compact disk, play them on your computer, or transfer them to an MP3 player. But you must not copy them for friends or use them for commercial purposes.
