The series follows Nick Groff and fellow paranormal researcher Katrina Weidman (formerly of the paranormal state) as they limit themselves to 72 straight hours in what they claim to be some of the most haunted places. The first season aired on Destination America from March 4, 2016 to April 8, 2016. The second season airs from December 16, 2016 to March 3, 2017 on TLC. [2] On November 20, 2018, it was announced that on December 4, 2018, it would premiere season three, returning to Destination America. [4] [5] [6] On February 14, 2019, Groff announced via an Instagram post that the Paranormal Lockdown would not return. [7] [8] The series will feature Nick Groff, a paranormal researcher who is on a mission to discover something new in paranormal locations, and paranormal researcher Katrina Weidman, who both spend 72 hours together to hunt for ghosts. Groff and Weidman believe that the longer they stay, the more souls will communicate with them and the more information they can gather about the unknown. Admissions investigator Ben Radford claims the claim to live 72 hours in a haunted house as some kind of challenge is absurd. People around the world claim to be living in haunted places, apparently longer than 72 hours. Before you can argue that you live in a haunted house, ghosts must be proven to exist, argue that the paranormal community has yet to be proven. There are many methodological problems with their research methods, according to Radford. They are unable to properly investigate and test their assumptions at almost every turn, making leaps of logic and guessing far beyond the evidence. Lockdowns, like what you see on this reality show, methods with equipment are not intended for this purpose to look for something that has not been proven to exist or even identified. A stake (such as these) is essentially a scientific experiment without science. Completely lacking controls. Groff and Weidman... walk around the house with a film crew, literally and figuratively in the dark. The only thing they test is the stamina of their video editors and the patience of their viewers.
