We are asking all visitors to book a date and time for their next visit to the museum. Play sessions are available twice daily from Thursday to Saturday at 9-11:30am and 1-3:30pm. The maximum capacity for each session is limited to 50 visitors, which is 10% of cmnh's building capacity. All visitors, including members, must register in advance before visiting online. Online registration is available 1 week in the past. \*If you are unable to book a seat for any reason, please [questions@childrens-museum.org](mailto:questions@childrens-museum.org) email us at the hotel. If you need to speak to us by phone, please call 603-742-2002 and leave a message. Sunday-Tuesday will return on Wednesday for bookings coming Thursday-Saturday. Hats off to the staff of our children's museum!!! – Before visiting by booking a ticket to visit the Amy Cobb Museum, you agree to follow our health and safety guidelines: Do not visit if you are sick with the symptoms of a COVID-19 visitor at the age of 24 months or if you experience symptoms of COVID-19 visitors over 24 months, you should always wear a mask on your mouth and nose at the museum. Gators and bandanas are not eligible to request acceptable face masks. If you or your child are unable to wear a mask due to a medical or mental health condition or disability, we are providing a special time for these families to visit (scheduled periodically according to their interests). All visitors other than those mentioned above must wear mouth and kowie masks at all times inside the museum. one family at a time). Keep a physical distance of more than 6 feet from employees and other visitors who are not in the group. No food or drink is allowed anywhere in the museum other than water or bottles. Adults are expected to help children follow the rules. We request that visitors stay with the individuals they visit. A group of visitors is defined as no more than seven individuals who have booked a ticket. See Driving Directions for more information. There is no designated parking lot in the parking museum. All parking lots for the museum stand through the town of Dover. Here are the parking options: progressive prices and metered parking increase from \$1/hour for the first two hours to \$9-8 for the first two hours, and \$2 per hour for the third and fourth hours. After 4 hours, the hourly rate increases to \$3. There is ample meter parking along Henry Law Park (using 10 Henry Law Ave for GPS), Washington Street (using 6 Washington Street for GPS) or Central Avenue and other downtown streets. Book online Frequently Asked Questions What are the videos and entrance fees you can't find anywhere? The museum is open From Thursday to Saturday and is closed from Sunday to Wednesday (excluding some holidays). Visit sessions are 9-11:30 a.m. or 1-3:30 p.m. (All exhibits and surfaces are organized between each session.) Admission is \$11 for adults and children 1 year and older, \$9 for seniors 65 and older, and free for children under 12 months, educators and members. We offer many discounts, how long can I book tickets before checking out our discount page for more information? Cancel reservations for up to one week at a time. What if you run late and can't go to the museum at the start of a scheduled session? If you can't go to the museum at the start of the session, don't worry. We have staff who welcome people inside for about 45 minutes, after which we knock on the door even if the door is closed and locked and we will allow you. If you arrive late, play time is limited and we continue to ask all visitors. At the end of the session, you can clean it. Why can't I pay for my ticket online? You need to book your tickets online before your visit, but you won't pay for them until you get to the museum. At that time, display evidence of discounts or coupons that you should apply for admission fees. How do I book a member ticket? To book a membership ticket, the primary member must register first (click Register at the top of the ticket page). If you've already registered, click Sign in at the top of the ticket page and sign in as the primary member. When you arrive at the museum, book your ticket and show your membership card. Has your membership been expanded? Yes, your CMNH membership has been extended to cover the time the museum was completely closed due to COVID19. To reflect this extension, we have updated all membership records in the database. When you visit a museum, you can verify your information by bringing a membership card (if it expires) or a photo ID. Coupons are displayed, EBT cards are delivered at the admissions desk upon arrival, and discounts are applied to the cost of the visit. Why can't I add enough tickets to my book? If you can't add as many tickets to your book as you want, there are fewer tickets than requests. If available, select a different date and/or time. I was able to book one ticket at the time and time we wanted to visit, but there are three of us. Can we add another two people to the booking when we arrive?No. If you have only one remaining ticket when you book your ticket, you have only one seat left before you can record the maximum capacity. We have very strict personnel restrictions for health and safety purposes and we are not able to admit you with additional guests. Please make another reservation. Or at the time, please email questions@childrens-museum.org to turn off those tickets. I booked my ticket online. Where are the tickets? You will receive a confirmation email after your ticket request has been processed. You will not receive an actual ticket, you will not be required to bring your printed ticket to the museum at check-in, and you will be able to view your booking by name at check-in. At that time, you will pay for admission minus any valid discounts or coupons. Our plans have changed or someone in our party is sick. Can I use tickets on different dates and times?No. We have very strict headcount restrictions for health and safety purposes. If you arrive at a date or time different from your booking, we will not be able to admit you. We would like to release tickets for other visitors, and will be happy to change your ticket schedule. Please email us during business hours: questions@childrens-museum.org. Has the museum ever enacted new health and safety protocols due to COVID-19? Yes, physically moving away - occupancy restrictions are posted for each exhibit (usually one family at a time), floor decals and dinosaur footprints guide visitors to the flow of traffic around the museum. Face covering - at the age of 24 months, all visitors and all employees should wear faces covering their mouths and noses at the museum at all time. Gators and bandanas do not qualify as acceptable face masks. For visitors who are unable to wear masks for medical reasons, we offer regular out-of-hours sessions based on your interests. Frequent hand washing and sterilization - The museum has 17 hand sanitization stations and 12 sinks that can be washed by hand throughout the building. Ventilation - we have increased the exchange rate of the building to the maximum level and keep the windows open where possible to maximize airflow cleaning and disinfection surfaces - museum staff will perform deep cleaning between each hour session, disinfect all surfaces and replace all exhibit props with a new set of disinfection. Some exhibits have been modified and items that are difficult to sanitize or do not touch the visitor's face or head have been removed. Disinfectant wipes are strategically placed around the museum for visitors, and staff will continue to clean high-touch surfaces during the day. The museum will request that all visitors and staff stay home if they are sick or experience symptoms associated with COVID-19 - stay home if you are sick. We're happy to reschedule your visit if necessary. All museum staff answer medical examination questions and regulate the temperature before each working day.
