The next Sunday there were 12 visitors who came to the service! We are continuing to pray for this young pastor and his new church.

We are beginning to prepare for the new year of teaching as well as planning for the new baby who will be arriving in barely two months!! The first week of September, I will be spending five days in Uganda getting to meet with some of the pastors and Bible college students there. Pray for the many hours of lessons I will be teaching during that time. Pray that it would be greatly used by God to encourage and grow these men in their faith.
