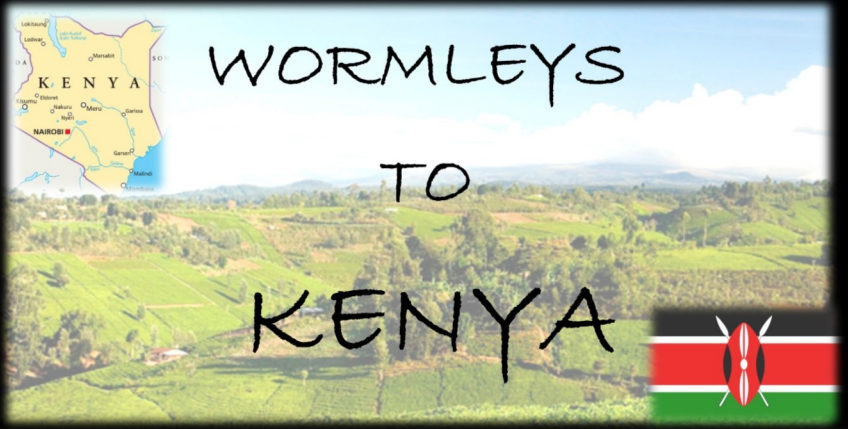


Serving in East Africa
