January 23, 2019, Yangon, Myanmar**

Dear Praying Friend,

It is our great delight and privilege to send out our annual report for 2018 as well as prayer Letter for January –March 2019.

We thank the Lord for enabling us to have our ministry for His glory and we thank all of our supporting churches as well as individual supporters who have been faithfully and sacrificially praying and supporting us. We thank the Lord for the school property He provided and the building permit he granted through the municipal authority.

By the Grace of God, I have been teaching the ten doctrines and pastoral ministry at the seminary. I preached 50 sermons at Grace Baptist Church and 15 at Grace Baptist Theological Seminary. I baptized 12 new believers. We have sent one missionary to a new field and resent one missionary to Kaya State. I made two mission trips this year.

We are graduating fifteen students this February. We are going to make family Gospel trip from the last week of February to March 2019. We are in the beginning of our seminary building construction. We had the groundbreaking last week and are now fencing the property. Our plan for this year is: to plant at least two new churches; to accept more new students; to emphasize on evangelism, mission and church planting.

2. The construction to be completed as planned (within 18 months).
3. The fifteen graduating students and their immediate future ministries.
4. The returning students and their summer ministries.
5. The mission trips of the faculty members as well as some of the students.
6. The health and growth of the churches.
7. The further study plan of our son Joseph Thang.

8. The health of Neng and Niang Thang.
9. Freedom of preaching the Gospel in the Country.
10. Peace, prosperity and tranquility in the country.

Once again, thank you very much for your fervent prayer as well as sacrificial supports without which we could never accomplish anything at all.

Please allow the landscape and us to attach the overall building project again and please do pray for the 30% still needed funds to come in soon.
