ON THE ROAD AGAIN!:

On the road again! But without children for the first time in 22 years. Nevertheless, God has been preparing us to become empty nesters.

This furlough God has been gracious in allowing us to live close to most of our children while they studied. We have also been able to spend meaningful moments with other Stateside relatives. We rejoice in the Lord always, but much more so when given time with cherished loved ones.

News from the Field:

Meanwhile, in Peru, the ministries go forward and lives are transformed. We are thankful for our dedicated co-workers who invest their time at the Bible college in Urubamba. Abundant Life Baptist Church in Arin is doing well under the able leadership of Pastor Saúl Sangama. The Árias family in Kiteni continues to reach out into that jungle community. They had a good attendance for their Easter service. It is exciting to report that the Lord has now provided over \$81,000.00 toward the first phase of the Kiteni church building project. We thank those who give and those who pray.

Other jungle ministries are suffering trials. Barbara's sister Becky Bass has been ministering in Salvación with her husband Bob and their son Colton. Due to complicated medical issues the doctor has recommended they change location. This interruption of their lives and ministries was a serious concern to all of us. Nevertheless, God's plan is always best and He has already provided a consecrated Peruvian couple to lead the growing flock in the church plant in Salvación. The Bass family could use our constant prayer as they transition into a new location and ministry.

Our daughter Flora and her husband Alex have been church planting a little over an hour from Salvación in the town of Pilcopata. Many have been asking God for wisdom and provision for Alex and Flora as they endeavor to help Luisa and her 4 children who are facing issues of violence from W. To complicate the situation, Alex's aged father is gravely ill, but lives at least three days travel away. Alex and Flora are considering the advisability of making the difficult and expensive trip with their two children. We would encourage you to lift up the vibrant church plant in Pilcopata at this time.

Family News:

Last week Cesar and Briana graduated from Collage and this week Caleb graduates from high school. Now, we parents will be resuming our furlough speaking schedule. We look forward to ministering in Iowa, Nebraska, Minnesota, South Dakota and Wisconsin before returning to Peru on July 30th.

Special Prayer Request:

We would like to mention one more prayer and praise item. Our daughter Briana has accepted a missionary internship position in McAllen, Texas, 20 minutes from the border with Mexico. She will be teaching 7th and 8th grade history and English at Macedonian Christian Academy. She will also be involved in Bethany Baptist Church (Iglesia Bautista Betania). Briana is interested in being a long-term missionary teacher in a bilingual setting, and is excited to get this experience over the next two years. She needs to raise about \$700.00 a month for this year, plus \$1,800.00 for travel and project costs. In no way do we wish to pressure anyone into supporting Briana. By the same token, she needs a personal prayer team, so we felt led to share her current mission with you. We plan to send out

her personal prayer letter with greater explanation within the next couple of days. If you do not respond to her, you will not go onto Briana's prayer team update list. On the other hand, if you would like to join her on this missionary adventure, be sure to respond to the letter we will be sending you. We are so thankful to see God at work in the lives of our children.
